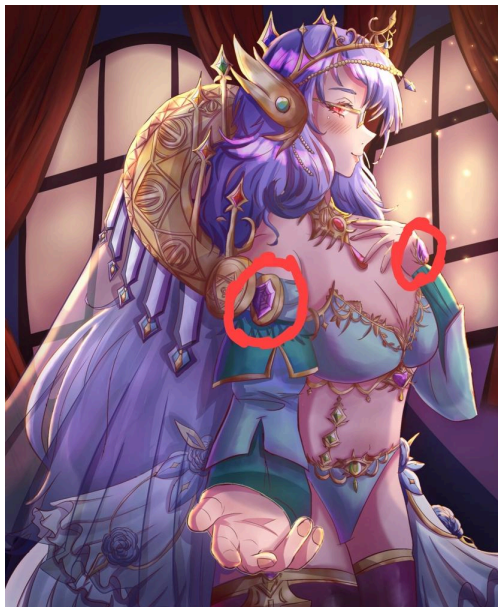

# 10. Tenth Picture (Bonus Picture Pt. 2. Art by Goofypea)



This is some reference sheet/moodboard of my OC, Honuria, in case anyone decided to make a fanart of her. Anyways, why is there many pictures? The reason is for reference sake and I'n gonna explain the parts of the pictures one by one so that you could pay attention on how to make her art:

1. **The first picture** is Honuria and her full body reference which is self-explanatory. Art by Quixowltic

2. **The second picture** is her upper body outfit reference where you could see what kind of things that got covered by her arms that was folded in the first picture.

3. **The third picture** that I circled is the emblem of her cape hanger. Yes, if you look at it, it is basically Star of David with an eye of ra in the middle and it was engraved by gold. What you see is the simplified version and was engraved in gold. Regardless, I would love you to make this as her emblem for her cape holder and yes, you can simplify it if you had a hard time as long as you stick to its spirit **\*\***(Addendum: If you look closely on the fanart, yes, Honuria wears a cape, a transparent silk cape just like Harvest Goddess from Harvest Moon for example: <https://encrypted-tbn0.gstatic.com/images?q=tbn:ANd9GcSg3SYEgNzZZNudQpdATljo62Q1KQXD-fklKg&usqp=CAU>, or any transparent cape from weddings that got hold by a cape hanger)

4. **The fourth picture** especially the part I circled is about the ear thingy that she had. Yes, when you look at it, the ear thingy resembles the fanart on the right. Albeit the difference is that it has green gem. So if you want to look for positioning of the ear thing, you could use the fanart in the fourth picture as a reference. Also, Quixowltic added some spiky stuff underneath the ear thingy, evidenced by the left side of it so you could add that too.

5. While I originally didn't want to include this. I decided to include the fanart of Nyi Roro Kidul in the **fifth picture** order to know what crown she wears due to it conflicting with the pike. Yes, it's exactly like that fanart of the fifth picture to an extent. Albeit the gem in question is light blue just like Quixowltic's fanart and her rose is replaced by the ear thingy in the fourth picture.

6. Speaking of pike, yes... **The sixth picture** is where I circled the examples of her two pikes on her cape hanger. If you ask me, there are like 7 pikes in total above the cape hanger, the red one hasn't been shown yet. This is due to the fact that it also mirrors the color of the gem had which resembles rainbow. Here's where things got complicated for me to explain due to perspective stuff: If you start on the left part of her body (Albeit this is only available if you view the left part as the right part of the body like a mirrored perspective), or in simpler terms, the right part of the picture, you need to start with the last color of the rainbow until the first for the gems until the last one, kind of like Quixowltic's fanart shown here.

7. Yes, if you look closely in the fanart, she wears a showgirl skirt (If you don't know, here's an explanation for easier things: <https://tvtropes.org/pmwiki/pmwiki.php/Main/ShowgirlSkirt>) However, the skirt doesn't cover her panties as she loves to show it anyways. **The seventh picture** is where I got the inspiration from the skirt from. It's the wedding dress of the character known as Levia from Echocalypse. Yes, it is huge but you could shrunk the size in order to not get conflicted with the transparent cape. And yes, don't add the thorn stuff from there to make things easier to draw. Also yes, the color of the roses should be the same as what Quixowltic colored

8. And now let's enter **the Eighth Picture**. The eighth picture is about the footwear she wears. If you look closely, yes... She wears stockings that reveals her thighs instead of boots. If you want to know what shoes she wears, it's on the right part of the picture. You could google Tharja from Fire Emblem as a reference for her own shoes too. However, one thing that could make the difference is the color of her shoes is that she wears a seafoam green/teal shoes. So yeah,

change the color to either green or seafoam green for the shoes to make things easier. And yes, keep her thighs revealed.

**9. Ninth Picture (Bonus Picture Pt. 1):** I forgot to say this but yes, as shown in the **Ninth Picture** I forgot to add, Honuria actually wears a cape if you look closely on the part that I circled. It is dangling on her cape hanger. Yes, her cape is somewhat transparent too like the picture on the right in the ninth picture. So much so you could also see her body and her outfit in general. The length of the cape should be until the shoe part to an extent unless you draw until the bottom part and manage to fit the skirt especially on the seventh picture. That's all I have to say.

**10. Tenth Picture (Bonus Picture Pt. 2):** So, Goofypea made this awesome art of Honuria and I include this one in the reference for those who want to draw it. I will always be indebted to Goofypea as well. If you want to know what kind of things you could take from the art reference made by Goofypea? Pay attention to the things that I circled such as the purple gem near the Star of David emblem as it was revealed that they also add a spider web pattern there (I would love to see it as it complements with her character. More on the Character Design analysis you could read below). And around her hand, there is an ornament that Goofypea made that I also circled too. I would love you to include said purple ornament around her hand that I circled from the art that Goofypea made so that you could include it in both hands as well.

**Personality Reference (Spoilers despite it isn't a final product yet):** She is an Empress with an interesting fashion sense (Loves teal/seafoam green as her favorite color and also wears revealing and fanservicey clothes due to her philosophy of freedom and yes, she will always love to change clothes but the core result is the same: Fanservicey, revealing as she show a lot of skin but also elegant and has teal/seafoam green as the main color as it is her favorite color) and a definition of Don't Judge the Book By Its Cover due to the fact that despite a goddess like appearance and charismatic nature such as her kind, motherly and calming figure (**You need to match the face personality of that of a motherly, benevolent, calm and collected figure instead of showing her being smug, that's the key here due to her appearance being so angelic**), she is pure evil villain who has committed tons of crimes under the sun for fun due to her twisted philosophy as well. She is also a parasitic entity, possessing several women to do her bidding and has existed ever since the universe existed since she's a daughter of a god. She will manipulate and ask everyone for alliance but in the end, despite the friendship that she made for other people, she views everything as a usable tool to reach her goal to destroy all of existence and recreate it in her twisted image. In addition, she is also partially responsible for the surrealistic and weird things that happened in the story. And yes, if you read all of this, I forgot to add that she is an eccentric figure which made her rather fun, be it the likes of Breaking the Fourth Wall, changing several clothes while wearing revealing clothes, had a multiple personalities like Junko Enoshima to an extent, viewing the world as an amusement park, even creating one, or viewing life as a theater to play, having scantily clad men (be it buff or not) and also scantily clad women as servants, doing surrealistic stuff or make the environment surrealistic just because she can and so on and so forth. She is also a thrill-seeker as well as despite having godly powers, she prefers to hold back and doesn't want to do god mode so that



the fights won't be boring to her. In addition, she has a massive complexity addiction in which she is very addicted to form long term or complex plans rather than making things simple because it's what made it fun.

P.S. you could make her entire body glow a light, that's entirely optional to you. **And yes, I should note that she is not a human and also use formidable magic spells like controlling elements, summoning chains with purple aura, creating barrier, healing and buffing her allies, teleportation, cloning herself and so on and so forth since she also used to be a daughter of a god too.**

That's all the pictures and references I could give for my OC, Honuria, to you. Sorry if this seems too detailed like Quixowltic's fanart but yeah... She's my personal favorite precious original character after all (Even if I will show more OCs some love). And I do want the best for her. However, if you think her design is too hard, it's okay, you could make a doodle or sketch and I'm fine with simplifying the design to make things easier. Regardless, let the drawing begin!

**Also, P.S. some character analysis that I made for Honuria if you guys are interested. Wall of text and spoilers incoming!:**

1. I think what I like the most about her is the fact that she wears revealing clothes. It fits with the type of the character she is. She is a seductress or a temptress that enthralls several important figures to do her bidding so it makes sense why she dressed like that. That and this is due to the fact that she has a penchant for wearing revealing and fanservicey costumes due to her philosophy of freedom, this also includes freedom of conscience where she can do whatever the kinds of atrocities that she inflicts towards innocent people. Her outfit also reflects her hedonistic and sadomasochistic nature as she loves to have some fun and all that.

2. The glasses that she wears, I think it also signifies the fact that perfect as she can be, it also reflects her blind heart due to her vile actions and a very fucked up philosophy and goals that she had endorsed even if she is wrong about the things she had followed. It also signifies that she is very smart even though her intelligence was intentionally used on a wrong path due to the stereotype about glasses people being smarter and how she relies on manipulation to do her bidding. The glasses itself also reflects Honuria reluctant self-righteous personality by claiming what she did would be better in the long run even if she hides sinister directions.

3. Some of her color schemes like seafoam green and purple. Purple represents wisdom, creativity, royalty, power, ambition, and luxury. It makes sense for Honuria considering she is supposed to be an Empress with high ambitions and is also a philosophical one even if she's wrong on certain things. The color seafoam green is her favorite color and to quote Canva.com: "Seafoam is a shade of green, which has strong associations with nature and the environment as it is the color of trees, grass and forests. It is seen as the color of luck, freshness, and renewal." It makes sense due to the extreme luck she had possessed and the fact that she is a parasite that has existed for a long time and possessed tons of women when she is defeated

and enthralls several civilizations to its own destruction so it could make sense why she could be a force of nature itself

4. Her eye color signifies that there is something off putting comes from her to an extent, making her somewhat inhuman. It also creates a false sense of security despite you could view her as the Big Good of the setting.

5. Her well endowed body figure. It makes sense because she is somewhat rather motherly and you can mistake her as a Big Good despite the false sense of security.

6. The pikes on her cape hanger to an extent resembles a clock needle, showcasing the fact that she had existed for a long time or being an eternal person.

7. The golden ornaments contribute to her hedonistic philosophy and the jewels in her outfit showcase her colorful and eccentric personality so yes. She is a very unpredictable woman for that alone.

8. Her skirt that shows her panties/thongs to show how shameless she can be in terms of showing her revealing parts or just committing atrocities.

9. There's also a hexagram/Star of David in her design, make that of you will for that one.

Now with that said and done, I have to admit that there are tons of little things that feel unintentional to add yet contributes to her personality which I always appreciated:

1. Thanks to Quixowltic adding several roses to her skirt, I will admit I like this feature as time went by because I think rose makes sense with some of her core themes. It could be pretty on the outside but when you got entrenched to her, the thorns could stab you in the end. And according to Aloha Foundation, these are the meanings of rose and the foundation: **Rose** is a highlight, success, small win, or something positive that happened today. **Thorn** is a challenge you experienced or something you can use more support with And **Bud** is the new ideas that have bloomed or something you are looking forward to knowing more about. It makes sense due to her curiosity and her tenacious personality that leads to success despite all odds and considering how Mary Sueish she can be.

2. The hexagon gem that me and Quixowltic created as Quixowltic added some patterns to that gem that looks like a web of spiders. I love this detail as the time went on even if this is unintentional. Probably because of the fact that this signifies the fact that she is a Master Manipulator behind the scenes to do her own bidding and the fact that spiders uses their webs to catch their prey.

3. A lot of people compared the old design of Honuria and maybe this one to resemble a mermaid. I have to admit that this comparison ended up making sense as time went by... The mermaid stuff is due to the fact I was inspired by Nyi Roro Kidul mythology when creating her

design and Nyi Roro Kidul is a famous mythological figure in my own country and the comparison makes sense due to her final fate I had for her in store: Her soul is imprisoned in the box and was then thrown in the deepest part of the sea, fitting for an untouchable goddess that sits on the top causing untold amount of misery towards innocent people.

That's all I could say with this fascinating character design me and Quixowltic created and I will always thank them for creating this art. And yes, I also have another OC created from the same artist if you are interested. Sorry for the long essay because yeah, when you think about it and see this, Honuria's design becomes more and more interesting to analyze even if she loves to change her outfit tons of times haha... She does look like an empress or the final boss now even if the older design for her by Cadelace is still good.
