2024-2025 Season at a Glance

We also are looking to expand our competitive teams, offering 3 teams, which will compete in multiple local competitions and National Theatre on Ice Competition in Dallas, TX.

October 4, 2024 – June 29, 2025 (total 9 months)

*All competitive teams will be required to attend 75% of practices in a three month period in order to perform with the teams (October-December, January-March, April-May). **Skaters must attend all practices the month of June.** If there are extenuating circumstances you'll need to discuss it with the coaches.

Our Adult program will adopt a new schedule this season, allowing them to compete at the ISI U.S. Adult Championships in Fall 2025. More information on this program will be available soon.

All Teams will have copious opportunities to perform in local exhibitions, shows, and ISI competitions. See the tentative calendar for more details.

Team Requirements

Intro Team

- LTS Level 4 and up.
- All Ages
- Audition Required for Placement
- USFS and ISI Membership required
- The skater is not required to take any private lessons, but it is highly recommended!

Preliminary Team

- Skater must have passed their Pre-preliminary Skating Skills test by the January 2025 test session.
- Ages 11 & under. 4 skaters up to the age of 14.
- USFS and ISI Membership required
- The skater is required to take AT LEAST 2 private lessons a week with their private lesson instructor(s). Learn-to-skate classes do not fill this requirement.

Juvenile Team

- Skater must have passed their Pre-Bronze Skating Skills test by the January 2025 test session.
- Ages 13 & under. 4 skaters up to the age of 16.
- ISI and USFS Membership Required
- The skater is required to take AT LEAST 2 private lessons a week with their private lesson instructor(s). Learn-to-skate classes do not fill this requirement.

Elite Purple Team

- Skater must have passed their Bronze/Juvenile SS test by the January 2024 test session.
- Ages TBD
- ISI and USFS Membership required
- The skater is required to take AT LEAST 3 private lessons a week with their private lesson instructor(s).

Silver Team

- Skater must have consistent forward crossovers - no tests needed this season
- Ages: 18+
- ISI and USFS Membership required

Notes:

- A skater audition is required for placement. Auditions will take place on Friday September 27th and Saturday September 28th. Skaters will receive an audition invite from the coaching staff advising them which audition to attend.
- If a skater does not have test requirements for a team prior to the start of season, they will not hold a permanent position in choreography until the test is passed.
- Parents in leadership positions and any skater over the age of 18 must take the Safesport training. You can link to the training through the USFS.ORG site.

Cost of Participation

Ice Theatre of the Rockies is a South Suburban Parks and Recreation program that represents the Denver Colorado Figure Skating Club. Due to being a rink run program, we are able to keep ice time and coaching fees at a significantly reduced price for the team. However, this does divide payments into two categories which are explained below.

Monthly Ice Time/Coaching Fees

The monthly fee will be paid through the South Suburban RecApp registration system and the class number will always be 65999 with the month number at the end. (Example: October Practice registration is 6599911) Cost will vary monthly, depending on how many practices there are. The per sessions fee of \$24/\$21 per practice and includes:

- Coaching Fees
- On-ice training
- Off-ice training

Skaters are REQUIRED to have a card on file that will be automatically charged for the previous month's ice time. Receipts will be sent via SSPRD portal by email.

Team Expense Fees

Intro Team

- One non-refundable deposit of \$75 per semester which will go towards team expenses.

Preliminary Team

- Three non-refundable \$200-400 deposits throughout the season which will go toward team expenses.
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Juvenile Team

- Three non-refundable \$200-400 deposits throughout the season which will go toward team expenses.

Purple Team

- Three non-refundable \$200-400 deposits throughout the season which will go towards team expenses.

Silver Team

- Deposits have not been finalized due to the shift in season for this team programming. Stay tuned for further information.

Notes:

- Team Expenses include the following costs: Costumes, competition entry fees, team photos, team dinner at travel events, team apparel/spirit wear and skate bags, coaching travel accommodations, coach competition fees, etc.
- Team Expense Fees **DO NOT** include skaters competition travel expenses such as airfare, hotel accommodations, etc.
- **Fundraising Opportunities** are offered and will apply to the skater's Team Expense fees. Participation can dramatically reduce these fees.
- No refund once team is in session.
- Skaters who are forced to withdraw due to injury or illness may qualify for a partial reimbursement at Managing Director's discretion.
- Skaters who are forced to withdraw for other reasons will not qualify for any reimbursement.
