Place child's name in every blank:
takes a yellow bus to school, to learn and play with friends.
Two grownups on the bus are the Attendant and the Driver. They are a team. They wear matching shirts and pants.
The Attendant is there to make sure gets on and off the bus with no problems.
The Driver is there to make sure the bus gets to school and home with no problems.
's family and school know who to call if they have a question about the bus.
In the middle of the school year, the school bus routine might change a little bit.
What if's school bus Driver on November 3 is not the same one who took to school before?
does not like changes. If there is a change to the team of grownups on the bus, might worry or be surprised, sad or angry.
That's OK can show those feelings to people at home and school.
can remember that the Driver and Attendant are still a team. In fact, the Attendant from before stays with's bus for a week until the new Driver gets to know everyone.
On November 10 there could be a new Attendant. Wow, two changes in a row! can remember that it's because that person was helping other kids get used to their new Driver on some other bus.
can notice that the new school bus Driver and new Attendant still wear matching shirts and pants.  The new Attendant still helps get on and off the bus.  The new Driver still gets the bus where it needs to go.  The same students are still on the bus and it still goes down the same streets.
