Our primary climate bill is the [Earth Bill](#), a comprehensive bill that will cut US greenhouse gas emissions by requiring 100% Renewable Electricity, Zero-Emission Vehicles, & Regenerative Agriculture by 2030.

We also support a number of other legislative solutions in a “Climate Bill Package” listed below, which oppose toxic substances that threaten both human and ecological health, promote environmental justice, and dial back fossil fuel production.

[Agricultural Resilience Act of 2021](#) S. 1337. [HR 2803](#).

Rewards regenerative agriculture, pasture-based livestock practices, and green energy on farms; reduces food waste in schools; revises food dating systems.

[Farm System Reform Act of 2021](#): HR 4421, [S. 2332](#).

Phases out concentrated animal feeding systems; invests in regenerative farming.

[Food & Agribusiness Merger Moratorium and Antitrust Review Act of 2019](#). 2019: HR 2933, S 1596. Halts corporate consolidation and investigates the impact of such consolidation.

[Climate Stewardship Act of 2021](#) S. 1072, [HR 2534](#). Establishes programs to offset farm emissions, plant millions of trees, and restore wetlands.

[FOREST Act of 2021](#). S. 2950 [HR 5506](#). Fostering Overseas Rule of Law and Environmentally Sound Trade Act. Combats deforestation by prohibiting the importation of certain products undergoing illegal deforestation.

[Break Free from Plastic Pollution Act of 2021](#). S 984 [H. 2238](#) Requires a variety of actions from corporations and others that will significantly reduce the production and use of plastics.

[Protect America's Children from Toxic Pesticides Act of 2021](#). Reintroduced Nov. 22, 2021 Bans harmful pesticides still in use in the US, empowers frontline communities to act on their own behalf.

[Environmental Justice for All Act of 2021](#) S 872. [HR 2021](#). Amends the Civil Rights Act to allow frontline communities to seek redress; allocates money to reduce public health disparities.

[Justice for Black Farmers Act of 2021](#) HR 1393 [S 300](#) Protects existing Black farmers, offers resources to displaced Black farmers, creates a Farm Conservation Corps.

[End Polluter Welfare Act of 2021](#). HR 2120. [S1167](#). Eliminates taxpayer subsidies to the fossil fuel industry; ensures funding for the Black Lung Disability Fund.

[Fracking Ban Act](#) 2019: HR 5857. 2020: S 3221. Phases out fracking nationwide by 2025; establishes just transition support for affected communities.

[American Renewable Energy Act of 2021. HR 3959](#). No Senate bill yet. Establishes a Federal Renewable Electricity Standard for retail suppliers.

[Ocean-Based Climate Solutions Act of 2021 \(H.R.3764\)](#). This bill establishes a variety of requirements to reduce carbon emissions and protect oceans, coastal habitats, marine mammals, and fish populations from climate change and other threats.
