Homecoming Ticket Information

- Homecoming tickets will be available for purchase online from September 9-20 and will be sold in-person in the Student Center before school and during lunch mods on September 17, 18 and 19. Follow the steps below to purchase your ticket online.

 - At the bottom of the page click "Have a Passcode?"
 - Enter your passcode (student ID number)
 - After submitting, the ticket level will appear
 - Add 1 ticket to the cart and checkout
 - Input your information and submit order
 - One ticket per transaction.
- Guest Tickets - Follow the steps below to purchase a ticket for a non-Mentor High student.
 - Visit your unit office and complete a Guest Permission form. All guests must be a current high school student.
 - In the student center during ticket sale time, present a completed Guest Permission form to receive a unique code to purchase a guest ticket in person or online.

Can I purchase dance pictures at the Homecoming Dance?

- No, a photographer has not been at our homecoming dance the past couple of years. Only about 4% of students used the photograph the past few years we had one and it is not financially feasible for the group to set up at the high school.
- **When is the Homecoming Dance?**
 - Our Homecoming Dance will be on Saturday, September 21 from 7:00-10:00 pm.
 - On Thursday, September 19 we will have our Homecoming Pep Assembly in the morning. Our Court will be introduced and the King will be announced.
 - On Friday, September 20 we will have our...

- Homecoming Parade around 5:00 pm which will feature the Court and schools throughout the District. Our Fighting Cardinal Marching Band will lead the parade.
 - Homecoming football game.
 - The Queen will be announced at the game.
- **What is this year's theme?**
 - The theme of this year is Tangled as selected by our students at the end of last school year.
- **How do we buy tickets?**
 - Tickets will be available for purchase online from September 9-20 and will be sold in-person in the Student Center before school and during lunch mods on September 17, 18 and 19. Students purchasing a "guest ticket" for a non-Mentor High School student will need to turn in a completed guest form to receive a unique code to purchase that ticket in person or online. Guest permission forms are located in each unit office. All guests must be a current high school student.
- **Where will the dance be?**
 - The dance will be held in our gymnasium with food and water available in the Student Center.
- **Where do we enter the building?**
 - Students and guests will enter through the F-wing entrance where buses drop off. Students will be breathalyzed before entering and their tickets will be taken in this hallway.
- **What should I do with my coat, purse and shoes during the dance?**
 - We will have coat checks available. These areas will be grouped by last name. Volunteers from our PTSA will work these coat checks and will hand students a ticket with their information. Students will be responsible to keep their ticket in order to pick back up their belongings.
- **Can I bring someone who does not attend Mentor High School?**
 - Guests from other high schools are permitted to attend if a guest form is completed and signed by the appropriate unit principal. Tickets for a non MHS student will NOT be sold until the form is completed. Students who do not currently attend high school are not permitted to attend our homecoming dance.
 - Senior Students & Prom - similar to past years we allow our seniors to invite guests ages 20 and under to Prom in the spring.
- **How can I get a guest form?**
 - Guest Forms will be located in each unit office.
- **Where should we park?**
 - Students and guests should park in the north parking lot by the Fine Arts Center and gym. If you have a limo or bus the driver can drop your party off outside the F-wing entrance and can park in the west or south parking lot.
- **Is there a dinner?**
 - Dinner is not provided at Homecoming or Prom. This helps keep ticket prices for dances lower and allows for students to individualize their experience. Snacks will be available as will water during the night in the Student Center.

- **Where can we sit when not on the “dance floor?”**
 - Students can go to the Student Center if they need a break and can sit and relax.
- **When can we arrive and when can we leave?**
 - Students can arrive at 6:45 pm and the dance begins at 7:00 pm. Students can leave at any point during the dance, but once you leave you are not allowed to return.
- **Will the police be present?**
 - Yes, at all of our dances we have multiple members of the Mentor Police Department attend.
- **Where are the bathrooms?**
 - We will use the restrooms outside the gymnasium that are used for events.
