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PENDAHULUAN

Template ini digunakan sebagai pedoman penulisan artikel untuk Jurnal ETAM PolNes. Artikel harus memuat **Pendahuluan, Metode Pelaksanaan Kegiatan, Hasil dan Pembahasan, Simpulan, Ucapan Terima Kasih (jika diperlukan)** serta **Daftar Pustaka**. Artikel ditulis dalam Bahasa Indonesia menggunakan jenis huruf **Arial**, font size 11, spasi 1.5, rata kiri kanan, margin atas – bawah masing-masing 2,5 cm **dan** kiri– kanan masing-masing 2,5 cm, menggunakan kertas ukuran A4 (210 mm x 297 mm). Panjang naskah 10-15 halaman, termasuk gambar dan tabel. Naskah disimpan dan dikirimkan dalam bentuk softcopy microsoft word (.doc, .docx).

Bagian pendahuluan meliputi analisis situasi, solusi dan target serta tujuan kegiatan. Analisis situasi memuat latar belakang masalah, kesenjangan antara kenyataan dan ideal, dan tujuan kegiatan pengabdian kepada masyarakat. Solusi dan target memuat garis besar solusi permasalahan, waktu dan tempat pengabdian kepada masyarakat, dan target.

Penulisan bagian-bagian dari pendahuluan ini dapat menggunakan sub-bab/sub-judul (jika diperlukan).

Sumber rujukan diutamakan berasal dari sumber-sumber primer seperti laporan penelitian (termasuk skripsi, tesis, dan disertasi) atau artikel-artikel penelitian dalam jurnal dan/atau majalah ilmiah. Sumber acuan yang dicantumkan di awal kalimat ditulis menggunakan sistem Nama (tahun), sedangkan bila dicantumkan di akhir kalimat menggunakan sistem (Nama, tahun).

METODE PELAKSANAAN KEGIATAN

Metode pelaksanaan kegiatan setidaknya-tidaknya menguraikan pendekatan yang digunakan dalam kegiatan pengabdian kepada masyarakat. Berisi lokasi dan partisipan kegiatan, bahan dan alat, metode pelaksanaan kegiatan, metode pengumpulan data, pengolahan, dan analisis data.

Apabila alat pengukuran data menggunakan kuesioner, maka perlu dicantumkan hasil uji validitas dan reliabilitas instrumen yang digunakan. Jika alat analisis menggunakan persamaan, maka persamaan ditulis dengan menggunakan microsoft equation, seperti contoh berikut:

Seluruh simbol di persamaan diberi keterangan.

HASIL DAN PEMBAHASAN

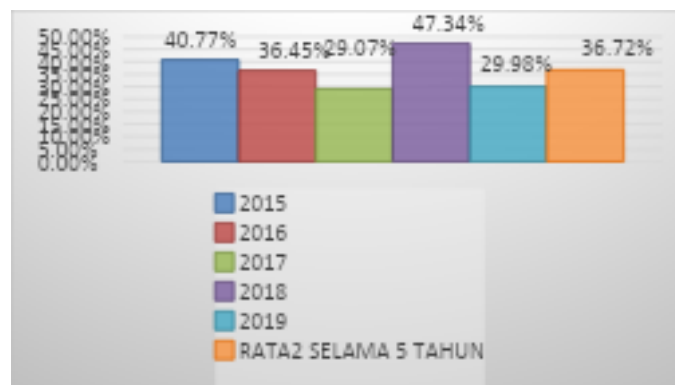
Hasil dan pembahasan disajikan dalam bentuk teks, Tabel dan/atau Gambar. Cara penyajian pada bagian ini dapat dilakukan: 1) pembahasan terpisah dari hasil atau 2) pembahasan menyatu dengan penyajian hasil. Hasil dan pembahasan berisi pelaksanaan kegiatan, analisis hasil kegiatan, kendala yang dihadapi, dampak, dan upaya keberlanjutan kegiatan.

Hasil analisis data dari software pengolah data, disajikan dengan mengetik ulang dalam tabel yang disesuaikan dengan kebutuhan, *bukan dengan cara meng-copy output hasil analisis*. Contoh penyajian data dalam bentuk tabel seperti Tabel 1.

SIMPULAN

Simpulan merupakan ringkasan atas kegiatan pengabdian kepada masyarakat yang telah dilaksanakan. Memuat makna hasil kegiatan dan jawaban atas tujuan kegiatan. Simpulan yang ditulis bukan proses *copy – paste* dari bagian hasil dan pembahasan.

Kebermanfaatan dan keterbatasan pelaksanaan kegiatan pengabdian kepada masyarakat dapat diuraikan di bagian ini. Saran diberikan untuk pengembangan dan kegiatan pengabdian masyarakat lanjutan.

UCAPAN TERIMA KASIH (jika diperlukan)

Penulis dapat menyampaikan ucapan terima kasih kepada pihak-pihak terkait yang terlibat dan telah membantu dalam kegiatan pengabdian kepada masyarakat pada bagian ini.

DAFTAR PUSTAKA

Hanya referensi yang dirujuk dalam makalah yang dimasukkan dalam bagian ini, dan seluruh referensi yang dirujuk harus tercantum di sini. Referensi yang dirujuk adalah 10 tahun

terakhir, kecuali untuk beberapa bidang ilmu tertentu yang membutuhkan referensi pada periode yang lebih lama.

Daftar pustaka merupakan bagian akhir dari makalah, ditulis dalam urutan alfabetis mengikuti **APA Style** (<http://www.apastyle.org>). Susunannya memuat: nama penulis, tahun publikasi, judul paper atau *textbook*, nama jurnal atau penerbit, dan halaman. Berikut ini beberapa contoh cara penulisan daftar pustaka menurut APA Style.

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
