What to Bring to the Lure Course

- **Appropriate leash/collar**
 - We recommend a flat collar, harness, or martingale collar. Make sure your leash is short and your dog is in your control! If your dog is wearing other types of collars/equipment, we may ask you to remove it during the run to reduce risk of injury.
 - **Car crate or tether**
 - Your dog will go wild when they realize where they are! Keep them from busting out of your car and getting loose with a tether or crate!
 - **Water and water bowl**
 - We always have water and bowls available, but many people prefer to bring their own.
 - **High-value treats/toys**
 - Break out the bacon! When your dog's run is finished, they may not want to leave! Bring some exciting treats or toys to get their attention!
 - **Sun protection**
 - There is some shade available while you wait, but smart Arizonans always have sunglasses, a hat, and sunscreen!
 - **Weather protection**
 - Mornings can be very cold in the winter months! Don't forget warm clothes and a hot coffee! Keep an eye on social media to know when the Coffee Run truck will be there!
 - **A friend or family member**
 - While it's not required, having someone with you can be very helpful when it comes to managing and catching your dog! Friends/Family are welcome to join you on the field during your run!
 - **Your camera**
 - Take all the pictures and videos you want! Don't forget to tag us on Instagram @azfriendslure or @friendsforlifeanimalrescue when you post them!
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What NOT to bring:

- **Retractable/long leashes**
 - Again, dogs are very excited and may act inappropriately toward other dogs. Your dog should be kept in control and within 3-4 feet from you. Retractable leashes are absolutely not allowed.
- **Off-leash dogs**
 - Gilbert has a leash law and you are required to keep them on leash in the area. The ONLY time they should be off-leash is while they are luring inside the fenced park.
- **Female dogs actively in heat**
 - This is a sanitary issue. Dogs in heat wearing diapers/britches will be allowed to run, as long as they are able to keep them on while luring.
- **Injured or sick dogs**
 - Don't make it worse! Keep them home!
