Verbirakenteiden tärppilista:

- 1. Preposition jälkeen verbistä ing-muoto
- 2. I **look forward to** see<u>ing</u> you \rightarrow **to** on prepositio
- I used to walk in the park during my free periods when I was at school. (oli tapana;
 to ei ole tässä prepositio vaan perusmuotoa edeltävä partikkeli →)
 I am used to walking and don't get tired very easily. (olen tottunut; to on prepositio)
- 4. I was born in 1994 (Aina passiivin imperfekti!)
- 5. I wish I was rich and beautiful (nyt) / I wish I had listened to my grandmother's advice (menneisyydessä) / I wish I would get a better job (tulevaisuudessa)
- I have lived in Sweden for five years. (jossain kohtaa elämässäni)
 I lived in Sweden for five years when I was a child. (imperfekti, kun ajankohta mainittu)
- 7. When **did you buy** that jacket? (When kysymyksissä perfekti ei käy)
- 8. If you <u>help</u> me, I **will buy** you a drink. (preesens futuurin sivulauseessa)

 If you <u>helped</u> me, I **would get** this thing done more quickly) (konditionaalin sivulauseeseen imperfekti)
 - If you <u>had helped</u> me, I **would have got** it done on time! (2. konditionaalin sivulauseeseen pl.perfekti)
 - If I <u>hadn't accepted</u> the task, I **would** now **be able to sit** in the sun and enjoy a cold drink!
 - Jos olisin tehnyt menneisyydesä jotakin (sivulauseen 2. konditionaalina pl. perf.), asiat olisivat eri tavalla nyt (tavallinen konditionaali päälauseessa)
- 9. John acts **as if** he <u>owned</u> the restaurant. (as if + imperfekti)
- 10. **It's time** you <u>started</u> to do something to get fit. (It's time + imperfekti)
- 11. **Let's** go, shall we? / Oh shut up, will you? (käsky + will you)
- 12. Let's not argue = Don't let's argue (mm. Agatha Christien usein käyttämä muoto)
- 13. I was about to bite into the sandwich when I discovered there was a lizard's tail hanging on its side. YUK! (olin puraisemaisillani)
- 14. We **are to go** to the police station at 9 o'clock tomorrow morning. (on määrä mennä)
- 15. Where did you **have your hair done**? It's gorgeous! (have something done, teettää jotakin)
- 16. You have to **have a doctor look** at that rash! It looks sore. (have sb do sth, teettää <u>jollakulla</u> jotakin)
- 17. He **enjoys being seen** with his new girl friend. (enjoy + ing-muoto; passiivi: be + 3. muoto)
- 18. Sheila is said to have five half brothers = It is said that Sheila has five half brothers

- 19. How many languages do you know / can you speak?
- 20. John **can't have been serious** when he proposed to to Ann. = It is impossible that John was serious when he proposed to Ann.
- 21. Ann **must have been** out of her mind when she said yes. (on varmaankin ollut, on täytynyt olla)
- 22. You **mustn't touch** anything. (et saa) / You **don't have to touch** anything (ei tarvitse)
- 23. **Remember to take** the dog out for a walk! (Muista tehdä!) I don't **remember buying** any fish. (Muista tehneeni)
- 24. People **living** in glass houses shouldn't throw stones. = People <u>who live</u>...

 Houses **built** of glass aren't very cool in the summer. = Houses <u>that are built</u>...

 Aktiivissa oleva sivulause → ing-muoto

 Passiivissa oleva sivulause → 3. muoto
- 25. **After completing** her homework, Jane went to the movies. **= Having completed** her homework, Jane went to the movies.
