Qu'avez-vous remarqué à propos de la personne avant même que vous ne lui parliez? (Expression du visage, langage corporel, etc.)	<i>I could tell that she was watching the dramas very attentively, but she wasn't smiling and seemed a bit guarded, like she wasn't sure if she wanted to stay..</i>
Qu'est-ce qui vous a amené à décider d'aller lui parler?	<i>Even though I didn't know what to say, I felt that God was urging me to talk to her.</i>
Comment avez-vous commencé la conversation?	<i>I walked up and asked her if she had any questions about the drama.</i>
Comment a-t-elle réagi? Quelle a été sa réponse?	<i>She seemed surprised that I approached her, but started asking me about the drama and what we were doing.</i>
De quoi avez-vous, tous les deux, parlé pendant la conversation? (Incluez autant de citations que possible.)	<i>I explained that we were there to share about Jesus, and she nodded as if she already expected that answer. She told me that she went to church when she was younger, but then something happened in her family that made her doubt if God was really there. She said, "<u>Nowadays I don't think about it much. I just tell myself that God isn't real and I try to live for myself. But today I came across you guys and I just wonder if there's a reason for this.</u>" I told her that I believed meeting her today was not by chance, and that I felt prompted by God to approach her. I also shared with her about a time when I felt that God was far away, and she listened carefully and seemed really eager to hear more.</i>
Qu'est-ce qu'elle a dit qui vous a marqué le plus? (Une citation)	<i>(see underlined above)</i>
Comment s'est terminée la conversation?	<i>We had to end the conversation because she had to leave, but she said multiple times "Thank you for taking the time to talk to me."</i>
Comment pensez-vous que cette conversation l'a affecté?	<i>I believe that God used that conversation to prompt some questions in her again.</i>
Quelle était leur expression pendant la conversation et après	<i>Her face was very serious during our whole conversation, as if she really wanted to know the truth. But at the end, I could see</i>

la conversation?	<i>that she was a bit more relaxed and there was a bit of hope in her eyes.</i>
Quelle est votre espérance / prière pour cette personne?	<i>I pray that God will continue speaking to her, to let her know that He is real and is still pursuing her.</i>
D'autres détails intéressants	<i>She told me that her son works close to downtown, and that she will try to bring him to see our "performance" next time.</i>
