FHC 1 [Theme: procedures, EO, Colpo]

You should have **5 regular FHC** sessions (including nursing home **OR** special sessions such as EO/procedures/colpo). You can also count CHHMP or Q clinic (SRFCs) as one of the sessions but **no fewer than three continuity Farrell sessions per week** under any circumstance. No more than two residents should go to each SRFC per week.

FHC 2 [Theme: career prep, prepare a didactic presentation on any topic in primary care, IMCC, FMIS coverage]**

If not covering FMIS should have 5 regular FHC sessions (nursing home may count as one session). You can also count CHHMP or Q clinic (SRFCs) as one of the sessions but **no fewer than three continuity Farrell sessions per week** under any circumstance. No more than two residents should go to each SRFC per week.

FHC2** (** indicates FMIS coverage) If you DO have Monday off for covering FMIS then should have **2 regular FHC sessions**.

Nursing home/SRFC should be in addition to that.

Please ensure residents have at least one morning or afternoon off for administrative time.

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FHC 3 [Theme: ABFM modules / board study prep, billing and coding, FMIS coverage]**

If not covering FMIS on Monday should have 5 regular FHC sessions. Nursing home may count as one session. You can also count CHHMP or Q clinic (SRFCs) as one of the sessions but **no fewer than three continuity Farrell sessions per week** under any circumstance. No more than two residents should go to each SRFC per week.

FHC3** (** indicates FMIS coverage) If you DO have Monday off for covering FMIS then should have **3 FHC sessions**. Generally one can be nursing home, SRFC, or other special session.

Please ensure residents have at least one morning or afternoon off for administrative time.

FHC 4 [Longitudinal Community Based Engagement]

Will have 4 FHC sessions. Nursing home may count as one session. You can also count CHHMP or Q clinic (SRFCs) as one of the sessions but **no fewer than three continuity Farrell sessions per week**. No more than two residents should go to each SRFC per week.

Residents will have 2 half sessions for community Engagement Prep. Residents will visit ARC on some Tuesdays while on rotation with a faculty member regardless of nursing home.

Residents will also be required to attend a community board meeting over zoom during the rotation with a short assignment on your experience to follow (please reach out to Dr. Encarnacion if you have not received an email from her the weekend prior to starting the rotation).
