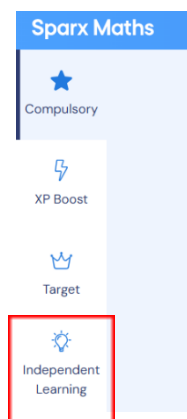


Overview of Maths revision provided

Sparx:

We use Sparx for the majority of our revision. This is because it is the scheme of work that we use, as well as trying to keep all your resources in one place. You can expect the following resources for your revision:

- Sparx homework. The homework on Sparx has a retrieval element that will be consolidating what the students have learned throughout the year. It is vital they keep on top of their homework to ensure they are getting this retrieval practice in.
- Sparx revision exercises, accessed once your teacher turns them on. This will happen roughly 6 weeks before the assessment. Pace yourself through these, it is **not** ideal to finish these as soon as they are available. These are found in the assessment section of Sparx.
- Sparx Independent learning tab (the section on the left when doing homework).



The image on the left indicates where to find this tab. Through this tab you will be able to use the Sparx codes provided on the revision lists to search for questions and guidance videos. You are also able to adjust the level of difficulty manually depending on your needs in a given topic.

Microsoft teams:

We use Microsoft teams to post resources to save you have to print endless lists and tasks and it gives ease of access to the material. You can expect that any revision materials will be put on Microsoft teams. Specifically:

- The Sparx revision workbook. These will have a lot of work for students to work on and are very large documents. Students should attempt this in small regular chunks as detailed in the guidance document. There are 3 documents, one for each term so they can work their way through the whole years' worth of study in manageable sections.
- The guidance document for how to best use the revision booklet
- The detail overview of topics in the test with associated Sparx codes.
- An 'at-a-glance' overview of topics in the test with associated Sparx codes.
- A revision timetable template as both pdf and editable word document. This is split into three sections – weekday, weekend and holiday for the students to make the best use of their planning.
