Alumni Access Objective

To create a warm and welcoming atmosphere for our former students, parents, and employees during their visits to campus while supporting the current school policies regarding attendance, child safety, and what is in the best interest of student learning.

To provide a platform through which alumni can connect with and contribute towards their alma mater.

To facilitate intergenerational exchanges—such as through a mentorship network—that connect and strengthen our community worldwide.



Procedure

All students who have attended AES (graduates and non-graduates) will be issued AES
Alumni Cards. All AES parent and employee alumni (who left on good terms) are eligible for
AES Alumni Cards.

NOTE— AES Alumni Cards do not automatically give access to the AES campus.

- Alumni who would like to visit the AES campus **must** schedule a visit prior to their arrival. They should email <u>alumni@aes.ac.in</u>. Should an alumni contact a staff member directly, please ensure the Alumni Office is aware.
- Alumni visits are allowed after school unattended from 3:30–4:30 pm. The visits on campus should not exceed 60 minutes.
- Visiting alumni must keep their visitor passes on for the duration of their visits and return them to the alumni office within 60 minutes.
- Alumni visits are limited to campus tours and meeting faculty members. They are not for socializing with other students.
- Class shadowing is not available in High School, Middle School, and Elementary School please follow up with the Alumni Office on the process.
- Alumni are not allowed access to any campus facilities (including pool, tennis courts, and gym) unless they are the guest of a current AES member OR they have received advanced permission from the Alumni Office.
- Alumni may not take any photos of current students or faculty without their permission.
- <u>Child Safeguarding</u> measures to be followed.

Procedures are subject to change at the discretion of the Alumni Office in consultation with relevant members of the Administration.
