TRANSITIONAL KINDERGARTEN INFORMATION NIGHT

The State of California is expanding eligibility for Transitional Kindergarten. Students who turn five between September 2, 2022 and February 2, 2023 will be eligible for Transitional Kindergarten next year. A TK information event will be held via zoom on January 13th at 7pm.

2022-23 ENROLLMENT

Enrollment for next school year will open on Friday, January 14. Continuing students do not need to re-enroll. Younger siblings who are entering the Piedmont schools for the first time must complete the <u>enrollment process</u>.
