Poster Project

Experiential learning also encompasses a group project to create a poster presentation on a family construct while incorporating a genetic condition.

- o This activity is designed to assist students to meet learner outcomes 1 and 2 and competencies 2 and 4.
- o Posters will be presented in class during week 7; you will also have the option to voluntarily submit a poster presentation recording for the University Research Month in April
- o Use the template available on D2L to create your poster
- o To develop the poster, students:
 - o Watch a movie from movie list (below)
 - o Research assigned genetic condition in relation to the family construct you've been assigned.
 - Look at genetic condition
 - Add family
 - Add family nursing
 - o Define family construct and relate why it's important, define genetic condition and relate to family nursing
 - o Provide exemplar case(s) that shows an example of the construct (ie: an excerpt from the movie could be an exemplar of the construct family struggling)
 - o Summarize research findings related to the family construct and genetic condition
 - o Make recommendations for nursing practice
 - o Pose questions that you feel still need to be answered
 - o Provide a reference list
- o Make your poster your own. All aspects need to be present, but add color and images as you like to make it unique
