SMF Field

- Full size artificial turf field.
- Large parking lot for spectators.
- Team bus parking - on the North Side of the ticket office parallel the field.
- **Ticket Sales** - Ticket office will open at 5:30 pm - not before | **Adults \$8.00 | Students \$6.00**
Cash and debit/credit will be available.
- Programs will only be available via QR Code – linked to the SSSAD website.

Gordie Howe Sports Center

- Large dressing rooms with washrooms and showers.
- There will be a concession operating during the game.
- Public bathrooms are located on the southeast corner of the building.

Teams - General Information

The stadium will open at 4:30 PM – **TEAMS ONLY!**

Water

- Individual water bottles can be filled from the dressing rooms.
- Water stations can be filled in the GHSC operations hallway – located in the center of the Gordie Howe Sports Center.

Dressing Rooms

- Saskatoon Holy Cross– Saskatoon Hilltops – East Side
- Regina Miller – West Side – first right once you enter the building

Players Bench

- Players benches are located on the west side of the field.
 - Saskatoon Holy Cross – West Bench (same side as the press box)
 - Regina Miller – East Bench (opposite side of the press box)

Headsets

- Each team will need to provide their own headsets for the game. Each team will be provided a spotter's booth (Home team will take #5, visitors will be #3).
- Please use the walkie talkie at center field to call for assistance should you experience difficulties.

In-game Video Technology - Game Strat

- Each team will have access to their own iPads if needed.
- The iPads are for coaching purposes only.

Medical

- Summit Sports and Health will be on site and providing medical coverage for both teams. They will be located at center field on the west side with the players. This group will initiate our emergency action plan should the need arise.

Statistics Package

- A detailed stats package will be available on the SSSAD website following the game.

Game Film

- SSSAD third party provider will be filming the game and loading it directly to HUDL.
- Home team to share film following the game.

Pre-game Protocol

- **6:20 PM** – Players and Coaches from **Regina Miller** will be introduced (as a team). Gather your players at the entrance to the field. Please run your team to their bench.
- **6:22 PM** – Players and Coaches from **Saskatoon Holy Cross** will be introduced (as a team). Gather your players at the entrance to the field. Please run your team to their bench.
- **6:25 PM** – Game officials will be introduced.
- **6:26 PM** - Teams will line up on the sideline for the pre-game ceremony.

- **6:28 PM** - Officials will call captains to center field for the official coin toss.
- **6:30 PM** - Kick-off
