

Tapescript Video 1 - Arthur and Merlin



(scene 1)

Arthur: What's going on? Mother? Father?

Ector: He's here.

(Merlin chuckles)

Merlin: So you're the boy.

Arthur: I'm Arthur. Who are you?

Arthur's mother: His name is Merlin and he is not welcome here.

Kay: Then he'll be on his way.

Ector: Put down your sword, Kay. Do as you're told, boy!

Arthur: Could someone explain what is happening here?

Merlin: The King is dead, murdered.

Arthur: So?

Merlin: Uther died with no legitimate son.

Arthur: What's that got to do with us?

Merlin: Not them. You... ...are Uther's son.

Arthur: No. My parents are standing here. Tell him... Tell him.

Ector: He's telling the truth, Arthur.

Arthur: He can't be. How can he be?

Ector: Merlin brought you to us when you were less than a week old. We swore to look after you.

Arthur: What?

Arthur: Take your lies and get out!

Ector: Arthur! Arthur, give me the blade. Give me the blade. Now...

(scene 2)

Arthur: Come near me and I'll kill you.

Merlin: Don't issue empty threats.

Arthur: Who are you?

Merlin: I knew Uther Pendragon. I was at his side when he died. The King's will, signed by his own hand, bearing his seal, attesting to your birth. This was your father's. Take it. When you were born, I took you and brought you here. You may be of king's blood but Uther was a barbarian. Placing you here made you so much more. I told Ector how to raise and educate you. He swore to keep you safe. They raised you well. Perhaps too well.

Arthur : Why? Why do you need me?

Merlin: Everything in time.

(scene 3)

Kay: I sometimes wondered why they doted more on you. You always got away with so much.

(scene 4)

Arthur: You'll always be my mother.

Ector: It's what you were born for. It's what we've guided you for. You remember what I taught you.

When you make decisions, you use...this in conjunction with this. And you never use that!

Arthur: I'll try and remember that. No son ever had a better father. I want you to know...

(scene 6)

(scene 7)

Merlin: We rest here.

Kay: This village? Is that wise?

Merlin: We'll find out.

Man: Stay on your horses and ride on through.

Merlin : We are on our way to the coast. Fear spreads like plague. We were hoping for shelter tonight.

Man: There's no welcome here.

Merlin: Not even for an old friend?

Man: Merlin, is that you?

Merlin: That's more like it.

Arthur: What would you have done if I'd said no?
