- Date & Place:** Saturday, April 5th, 2025, at Pearl River High School
- Rules:** National Federation recognized
- Track Events:** F.A.T. timing system will be used
Schools supply own batons
- Field Events Relays:** Two (2) competitors per relay team
- Restrictions:** **¼ inch pyramid spikes. No Blocks.**
- Participations:** A Frosh-Soph athlete may compete in both Frosh-Soph and Varsity divisions for all events (except the shot put and discus) **but** must adhere to the NYS rules of four (4) events for the entire meet.
- Scoring:** 10-8-6-4-2-1 in each division, boys and girls separate. **Field event relay athletes will automatically be paired after the event is complete by the timing system.**
- Awards:** Medals for 1-5 places in each event (varsity and frosh-soph).
Trophies to top two schools (boys & girls) in Varsity and Frosh-Soph.
Backpacks to the male and female steeplechase winners- Sponsored by Fleet Fundraising
- Sanction:** A sanction has been filed for all bordering states.
- Entry:** *Maximum of four (4) teams per relay.*
Unlimited in **individual** track events.
- Entry Fee:** \$600 Blanket Total Team Entry.
\$350 Entry Blank per gender.
- *** **PLEASE NOTE:** Minimum Entry Fee is \$80.00 (per team)***
This is an Entry Fee and not a Participation Fee!
Boys and girls teams from one school are considered to be 2 teams. Therefore, the minimum entry for a boys' team and a girls' team would be \$160.00.
Twenty (\$25) dollars per relay (track & field event). Ten (\$15) dollars per individual event.

Dear Coaches,

Thank you for your interest in the 36th Annual Pirate Relays.

As always, it is our goal to incorporate a friendly and inviting atmosphere with a competitive field of performances.

Please note the following, for the throwing events, to help with a competitive varsity section and to move the meet faster-

- *The Morning Throws session will now incorporate both Frosh/Soph and Novice Throwers.*
- *Each school will be allowed FOUR relays (8 athletes) in the Frosh-Soph Section.*
- *Each school will be allowed TWO relays (4 athletes) in the Novice Section.*
- *There will be a brief warm up session and then an "open circle" with no flights.*
- *Throwers will throw twice in a row, and officials will measure the best of the two throws. He or she will then get back in line for his or her final measured throw.*

The Varsity session will be a traditional setup with three measured throws. However, we will limit each team to TWO relays (4 athletes). If you have a third relay that you would like to get into the varsity session, email me with performance information and we will see if we can accommodate (Note- All three of your relays should be able to score based on previous years).

Please note the following changes to the pole vault

- *Novice pole vaulters can vault in the morning session alongside the frosh/soph. The heights will progress 5'6"-6'6"-7'6"-8' (and up by six inches thereafter)*
- *Morning session vaulters will have only the option of standard placements of 45-65 or 80- until there are only 5 vaulters remaining. Then they can be more specific.*
- *Afternoon session -Varsity Pole Vault will have no standard placement regulations and progress:*
 - *Boys 8'6"-9'6"-10' (and up by six inches thereafter)*
 - *Girls 6'6"-7'6"-8' (and up by six inches thereafter)*

****Novice athletes cannot score in the Frosh/Soph division.***

Entries will close at 9:00 PM on Friday, April 4th.

Scratch sheets will be set up at the meet.

Additional changes can be made at the timing table. Please try and keep these to a minimum.

Purpose of Form
