

Some spots in Hanburton

The Diner – A quintessential pub serving great food in large portions for a decent price.

Allows regular patrons to run a monthly tab. Run by a retired miner and his wife. Closed on Sundays. Open 24 hours, 6 days per week. Has a rush at 5am for shift change in the mines. Friendly local staff.

Cacophony - A basement beer bar with darts, pool tables, and flight simulators. Live music of the loud, angry, male, youth variety. Run by a physically disabled former miner, who opened the club with his disability pension. Staff are indistinguishable from the patrons to those who should not be patrons. Open Thursday to Sunday from 6pm to 4am.

The Blue Parrot – A host/hostess bar for the lonely and well-paid. Well-stocked bar, attractive and interesting interior, many theme nights. Open 6 days per week – closed on Mondays. Noon to 6am.

Dick's Café Andurien – The hotspot for technical and military personnel not working in the mines. Live music, gambling, and sports nights. Good, limited menu. Well-trained staff, mostly expats. Open 7-days per week from 7pm to 4am. Fitz' former boxing sponsor.

Velvet Indiscretion – A brothel masquerading as a host/hostess bar. Always open.

Lilly's Death From Above - Mechwarrior wannabe bar. Sports décor dominated by the remains of a Griffin's head and arms. Simulators are top of the line commercial models. Wide selection of imported alcohol, and a decent menu. Good staff. High prices. Open from 11am to 2am, 7 days per week.

The Brig – Known to be the first tavern in this company town, the establishment has long since changed to private ownership and expanded both its menu and its clientele. A simple tavern with a friendly, neighborhood vibe, quiet, dim interior, good seats, and lengthy discussions about sports, spouses, the weather, and other weighty matters. The bartender is ancient, and has a calming influence on others. The waitress is motherly, and knows everyone. Happy hour is 6-10. Open 5 days per week, closed Sunday and Monday. Opens at 11am for a daily lunch special, closes at midnight. Quite possibly the best steak on Oliver.
