Introduction

Delphia Welford was likely born in Okolona, Mississippi on 9 September 1875 as the daughter of Richard and Heddie Welford. The family moved to Humboldt, Gibson, Tennessee when Delphia was still a child. She had one son, Leo Mathis in the late 1890s. Delphia never married and spent the rest of her life in Humboldt. Delphia Welford died in Humboldt, Tennessee on 14 November 1992, likely aged 117 years, 66 days.



There is proof of birth, mid-life documentation, and death. This case is interesting because it appears that most of the Welford siblings deflated their ages later in life. There is strong evidence that the 1880 US Censuses belong to the correct family, the biggest surprise is that a child named Delphia Welford is listed as being five years old in both censuses, ruling out the possibility that her age was inaccurately recorded in one of the censuses. There is furthermore a younger sibling aged two in both the censuses, meaning that a birth in September 1877 or later is extremely unlikely as well.

The 1900 US Census lists a young woman named Della Welford as living in Humboldt, TN. With Della are two individuals that reappear in the definite 1910 and 1920 US Census matches for Delphia Welford, Mattie Roe and Delphia's son Leo. The 1900 US Census lists a birth in April 1876, which isn't really consistent with her claimed birthdate of September.

The 1910 US Census lists Delphia Welford with her son and a few other people, including Mattie Roe, as living in Humboldt, TN. This document lists Delphia as being 27 years old and her son as being 14 years old, suggesting she gave birth at the age of 13.

The 1920 US Census lists Delphia with her son, his wife and daughter, Mattie Roe and a few other people in Humboldt, TN. Delphia's age is now given as 46 (an age of 36 was first written then crossed out).

The 1930, 1940 and 1950 US Censuses record Delphia Welford as being 50, 60 and 68 years old, respectively. She's listed with her son's family in Humboldt, TN.

The 1965 SSA shows that Delphia claimed to have been born on 9 September 1880 at

The articles from 1966-1992 confirm Delphia's identity and rule out the possibility of an identity mix-up/theft.

The obituary and SSDI confirm that Delphia Welford died in Humboldt, TN on 14 November 1992 and that she claimed to have been 111 years old at the time.

There is very strong evidence supporting Delphia Welford having been born in either 1874 or 1875, rather than 1881 as she herself claimed.

From the investigation on her relatives we see that all the siblings that I could find documentation for deflated their ages by five or more years later in life or at the time of their deaths.

The only possibility that Delphia Welford wasn't extremely old is if she was born in the early 1880s but wasn't enumerated in the school censuses or the 1900 US Census, which appears unlikely considering that there is a 1900 US Census match for a Della Welford listed with two people that appear in the 1910 and 1920 US Censuses for the definite Delphia Welford.

The obituary for Delphia Welford mentions that she was born in Okolona, MS and moved to Gibson, TN as an infant. The 1900 US Census for Gibson, TN list only one possible candidate for Delphia Welford.² All other listed people with soundex similar names can be ruled out because they are either listed with their parents or are even older than the woman aged 24 in the census record.

To the mix of deflated ages we can add that Delphia's son, Leo Mathis, claimed to have been born in 1901/1902 at the time of his death but that the 1900-1940 US Censuses all suggest a birth in 1897 or earlier. Leo's SSDI³ and grave⁴ both suggest a birth in the 1800s as well.

The lowest possible age validated as, based on the gathered documentation, would be 9 September 1876 and a final age of 116 years, 66 days (assuming the April 1876 listing in 1900 isn't considered the lowest possible age, then she'd be four months older, or a possible birth in April 1877 but then that would contradict the six earliest documents).

The highest possible age validated as, based on the gathered documentation, would be 9 September 1874 and a final age of 118 years, 66 days.

All this taken together, I find it very likely that Delphia Welford was born on 9 September 1875 and died on 14 November 1992, aged 117 years, 66 days.
