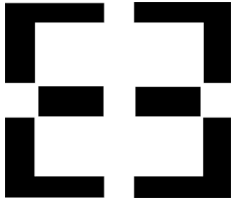


CLASSROOM WOFOROS



“Woforo dua pa a, na yepia wo”

“When you work for a good cause, you will get support”

Woforos are parent volunteers (or "room parents") who act as helpers to support our facilitators. For the Lower Village, we pair at least one Woforo with each LV *classroom*. For the Upper Village, we pair at least one Woforo with each UV *facilitator*.

What Does a Woforo Helper Do?

Woforo helpers will harness the energy of parents from each LV class to:

- Collect contact information for their class directory
- Ensure emergency cards are collected for each learner
- Help organize field trip logistics
- Level classroom libraries (training provided)
- Coordinate volunteers for Ms. Susie's art class (LV)
- Coordinate volunteers to help with clerical tasks (photocopying, cutting, prepping, etc.)
- Assist in coordinating classroom celebrations (e.g., 2nd grade “book publishing”; holiday parties; etc.)
- Kindergarten: coordinate volunteers to serve as Mystery Reader and assist with Motor Fitness
- Organize Facilitator gifts (holidays, birthdays, etc.)
- Other helpful tasks as requested by the facilitator

Woforo helpers also assist the PTSA throughout the year by engaging parents to assist in various events.

- Monthly **Facilitator snacks** (one month per grade)
- Assist in **Support Nea Now** (SNN) communication to families (Sept-Nov)
- Support **Nea Night Out** – work with parents to create a gift basket for auction (Feb/March)
- Support the **Walk-a-thon** (April)
- Organize **Facilitator Appreciation Week** (early May)
- Assist as needed with **Crossing Over** ceremony (June)
