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1.1. Book reviews should have a maximum length of **1,500 words** and must focus on a **single published work**.

1.2. Authors must prepare their manuscript using the **Book Review Template** available on the journal website. Please ensure that you download and use the specific template for reviews rather than the article template.

1.3. Manuscripts must be submitted in **Microsoft Word (.doc or .docx)** or a compatible editable format.

1.4. The review text must be written in **Corbel, 12-point font**, with **1.15 line spacing**. The formatting provided in the journal template should be maintained throughout the document.

1.5. The first page must include the complete bibliographic information of the reviewed work, including:

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1.6. Book reviews should provide a **critical and analytical assessment** of the work rather than a purely descriptive summary. Authors are encouraged to discuss the book's main arguments, contributions, limitations, and relevance to the field.

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
