

Our Peer Review team is made up of faculty members who have completed the official Quality Matters Peer Review course. The process is listed below.

- 1. The faculty member will receive an email from a member of the Center for Excellence in Teaching and Learning (CETL), with a link to a Self-Review document and the current rubric
- 2. The Self-Review is sent back to the CETL by the instructor. If there are problems with the Self-Review, communication is made to the faculty member, and then a team of three reviewers is assigned to the course.
- 3. The review is completed by each member individually using the rubric.
- 4. The review team meets together to form a consensus.
- 5. The review team sends the review to the CETL.
- 6. The CETL communicates the results to the faculty member.
- 7. The faculty member communicates with their supervisor.
- 8. An appointment is made with a CETL team member if the faculty member wishes to discuss or make improvements.
