

FAQ (Frequently Asked Questions) about the Bowie Baysox “Read & Hit a Home Run” Reading Program- for grades K-5

How do I keep track of the books I am reading?

Tell your teacher so that you or they can make a check mark on the incentive tracking poster in your classroom. Your teacher will decide how/when the check marks are written on the poster.

Where can I read the books?

Anywhere- inside or outside of the classroom, in your reading group, in the car, while waiting for the bus

When do the books need to be read by?

March 21st- 2 days before spring break; this will allow Mrs. Williams to get the final numbers for tickets to the Baysox coordinator, Dani Fox, so that the tickets can be sent to our school

Do parents/guardians need to do anything to receive the tickets?

No; just remind your child to tell his/her teacher if they completed a book at home. Most books will be completed within the classroom during independent reading time or reading group.

What if I need more tickets?

You can reach out on social media if you want more tickets for your family and someone you know is not using them all. There will be an opportunity to purchase additional discounted tickets in April.

When is the baseball game?

Friday, May 10th at 7:05 pm

When will I receive the tickets?

As soon as I receive them in April, I will distribute them to students along with a flier containing information about the recognition day. You will receive one ticket for an adult and one for the child completing the program.

How many schools participate in this program?

Over 150 schools across the region, in 9 different counties

What kind of tickets will we receive?

The tickets are for the open seating areas. If your friends or even your teacher are planning to go to the game, try to coordinate a meeting spot so that you can sit together. Maybe we can create some Phelps Luck posters to sit together!
