


This is the second biannual winter fat bike festival fundraiser hosted <u>C4XC</u>


Staging Area

This course is open to the public, located on Alberta Parks and Public Lands.

First Aid/Medical


We will have trained responders on site. Please identify yourself to the organizer if you need assistance.
