# DLA Statement Calling for Ceasefire in Gaza

The Social Justice Committee of the Delaware Library Association (DLA) joins professional organizations in our field including the <u>ALA</u>, <u>ALA SRRT</u>, <u>APALA</u> (1), as well as our state legislature (2) in calling for an immediate ceasefire, delivery of immediate humanitarian aid to Gaza, and call for an end to the epistemicide being carried out through the destruction of libraries and archives in Palestine.

The Delaware Library Association stands in solidarity with oppressed people everywhere, including the Jewish people and the people of occupied Palestine. We grieve for all those killed and all those impacted by the violence that took place on October 7th and the violence which has escalated in its aftermath. We vehemently condemn antisemitism and Islamophobia, both of which have been widespread in the wake of this violence. We condemn these hateful acts here in Delaware, the United States, and abroad. We reject the idea of the Israeli government and its actions as representative of Judaism and the Jewish people; we likewise reject the idea that any criticism of Israel or condemnation of the violence in Palestine is inherently antisemitic. We reject authoritarianism in all its forms.

As information workers and per ALA Policy B.2.8, it is especially relevant for us to condemn the destruction of libraries, archives, schools, and other sites of information access and collective memory in Palestine due to Israel's assault on Gaza (3).

The current attacks have resulted in the destruction of many Palestinian libraries and archives (4), including but not limited to:

- Gaza Municipal Library, Gaza's main public library;
- Rashad al-Shawa Cultural Center and Diana Tamari Sabbagh Library, a key historical site where in 1998, President Bill Clinton visited with Israeli and Palestinian leaders;
- Central Archives of Gaza City, which contained documents integral to the cultural heritage of Palestine, dating back 100 years

In light of the losses documented above, in accordance with our fellow professional organizations and in line with ALA Policy B.2.8,

- We call for an immediate and lasting ceasefire and delivery of humanitarian aid to Gaza;
- We call for an end to the destruction of libraries, archives, schools, and other sites of information access in Palestine;

- We condemn any and all antisemitism and Islamophobia in discussion of the events in Gaza:
- We call upon our fellow state library associations to join us in calling for a ceasefire and condemning the destruction of libraries and archives in Palestine.
