FUTURE TENSES

Future Simple S + will + V1

Future Continuous

S + will + be + V-ing

I will be watching TV at 5 pm tonight.

Don't call me at 11 am because I'll be working.

Future Perfect

S + will + have + p.p. (V3)

I will have finished the course by November. When you come to my place, I'll have finished working.

Future Perfect Continuous

S + will + have + been + V-ing

I will have been studying with Elena <u>for 2 months</u> when winter begins. By the end of this month I'll have been studying English <u>for 2 months</u>. By December of 2020 I'll have been working <u>for 20 years</u>.
