

The Route to the Adult Grand Prix Open Tournament



The Adult Grand Prix is NorCal's culmination of the season. Players work all year long to earn ranking points in order to qualify for the tournament. Each tournament you play will give you points and put you on the National Standings List. The more points you have, the better your chances to get selected into the Grand Prix.

To be eligible for the Grand Prix tournament players must be USTA NorCal members and must have played at least one (1) sanctioned tournament in the NorCal section. The Grand Prix tournament will be a **Closed Level 4 tournament** and will count toward the Standings. All players must register in order to be considered no matter how highly they are ranked.

In the Open divisions the top 16 players in the men's singles division and the top 8 players / teams in the women's singles and all the doubles divisions will be selected to play in the Grand Prix event. Doubles teams for all adult Grand Prix events will be selected by combining the two partners' individual points and selecting those teams with the highest combined totals.

The 2025 Adult Grand Prix Open division will have \$5,000 prize money for all divisions, divided as follows:

Champion: \$500 per player/team

Finalist: \$300 per player/team

3rd Place: \$150 per player/team

4th place: \$50 per player/team

**Prize money will be adjusted if draws don't fill*
