Labrisz Carnival House Rules

Name of the Labrisz Farsang: Carnival.

Entry to the Carnival area is only allowed with the purchase of a wristband. Wristbands are non-transferable.

By entering the Carnival, visitors automatically accept the Carnival House Rules and agree to be bound by them.

Visitors must refrain from any behavior, statement, or action that could endanger or violate the personal rights, life, health, or physical integrity of others. Hate-inciting behavior is prohibited. The Carnival organizers reserve the right to deny entry to anyone they believe intends to engage in such behavior. By entering, visitors also accept that the organizers may ask individuals who behave inappropriately, aggressively, or in a hate-inciting manner to leave the festival area. If this does not occur voluntarily, the organizers, volunteers, or security personnel appointed by the organizers may escort the offending visitors out of the venue. Any demonstrations or use of propaganda unrelated to the organized event are strictly prohibited.

The use of mind-altering substances is prohibited throughout the Carnival area. Smoking is allowed only in designated areas.

Intoxicated individuals or those under the influence of mind-altering substances are not permitted to attend the Carnival.

It is strictly forbidden to bring hazardous or flammable items, sharp or cutting tools, explosive or pyrotechnic materials, dangerous chemicals, or any firearms into the Carnival area.

All visitors are responsible for protecting the equipment and objects at the Carnival venue. All equipment must be used as intended, and vandalism is prohibited. Visitors are liable for any damage caused.

The organizers are not responsible for valuables brought into the Carnival area or left in the cloakroom.

The organizers reserve the right to deny access to the venue or use of its facilities to individuals or groups who fail to comply with the House Rules.

With the consent of attendees, the program organizers may make recordings at the Carnival and retain them in accordance with the Labrisz Association's data protection policy.
