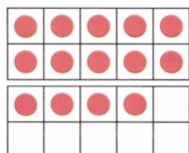
Retelling a Story

LEARN: Choose a story to watch from Cool Kindergarten found [HERE](#).

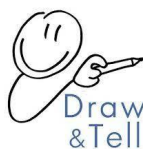
DO: Using a tablet or smartphone, record a video of yourself retelling the story you just watched. (HINT: FIRST, NEXT, THEN, LAST).

LEARN: Watch this [VIDEO](#) about place value and making and breaking apart two-digit numbers.

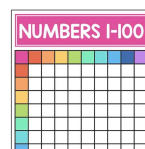

DO: After you look through the story a few times, choose the drawing you like the most. Create a story as if you were in the drawing. Using a tablet or smartphone, make an audio recording of yourself telling the story about you in the drawing you chose.

LEARN: Practice counting to 100 by watching the [COUNT TO 100 SILLY SONG](#). Then see if you can count backward from 100 by watching the [VIDEO](#).

DO: Using a tablet or smartphone, make an audio recording OR movie of yourself counting BACKWARD from 20 to 0.

OR Play [Balloon Pop Math](#) and Select COUNT BACKWARD FROM 20 to practice counting backward from 20.

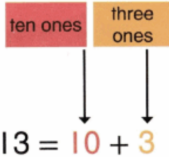
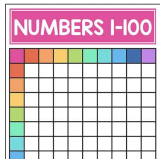
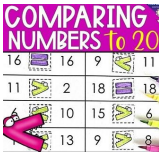
