Upcoming Testing Dates

April 13 is the state PSAT and SAT testing day for grades 9 -11. Details for each grade level can be found here.

WHO?

All LCHS freshmen (PSAT 8/9), sophomores (PSAT 10), and juniors (SAT). No need to register. Seniors: this is a non- attendance day.

WHAT?

The State of Illinois and Lakes Community High School want all students to experience the PSAT or SAT for college planning. For juniors, the SAT is a graduation requirement. Families will be able to plot student growth through the three tests to predict SAT scores by creating a student College Board account. This account should be in the STUDENT'S NAME. AP students already have an account created; be sure not to create a second account. The junior year SAT includes the essay section and can be sent to colleges during the application process.

WHEN?

April 13, 2022. Testing will start at 8:00 am. There is no zero hour on April 13.

Make-up testing for Juniors, Sophomores, and Freshmen will be April 27.

WHERE?

Lakes Community High School. Testing rooms will be on posters in the main entrance as well as emailed in advance to the students.

WHAT TO BRING?

- Wear layers (rooms can be warm or chilly)
- #2 pencils (No Mechanical Pencils)
- Eraser
- Calculator, extra batteries and a back up calculator. A limited amount of calculators will be available to check out on the third floor.
- Small snacks and drinks (packed away during testing)
- NO PHONE OR ELECTRONICS (including smart watches). Leave these at home or in lockers. Students will be dismissed per College Board rules if these are present during testing.

When students take the SAT as a part of SAT School Day, they are entitled to send test scores—for free—to as many as 4 colleges, universities, or scholarship programs. Colleges and universities are always eager to get scores from students, even if they're not ready to apply. Students can also add these four codes to their answer sheet on the test day.
