The application has three parts:

- General Questions (everyone has to do these)

General Questions:

1. What makes a good committee member?
2. What does the future of MUSKI look like?

3. What is your best party trick?
 4. What is your greatest strength and your biggest weakness?
 5. Committee are all in the Hunger Games, who wins, who loses? Explain in depth?
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Brand Sec Questions:

1. What is MUSKI's biggest selling point? What can MUSKI offer supporting Brands?
 2. When I got the Brand role, I was told it consisted mainly of emails. This is wrong. What, in your opinion, is the best way to get in contact with Brands?
 3. What are your plans for applying to ambassador programs for next year?
 4. What is the funniest sponsor you think MUSKI could get and come up with a name for the social to launch the partnership?
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SKI captain questions:

 2. What would you bring to the role of Ski Captain that would make you stand out?

2. Please design one new merch item you would want to introduce next year and add the design to your application.

 4. Every year we need 2 trip tee designs, please design a trip T-shirt for a potential trip next year.
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Social Sec Questions:

1. In your opinion, what skills or qualities are most important or crucial for a social sec? Explain how you have these skills and how you have demonstrated them in the past?
 2. Create a new and unique social proposal. Include all the details and how you will make this work and ensure it runs smoothly, including pricing and costs.
 3. OOPS your social has totally flopped, we really need to increase the vibes in here. What are you doing to make a small group or an empty room feel like this is how it was always planned to be? We need some entertainment!
 4. Your next social is slowly creeping up on you, and sales have massively underperformed. You had an agreement with the venue you would bring at least 150 people, but you are only on 40 tickets right now. What are you doing about this and how are you promoting the social?
 5. Green bag, white bag, red cup, rank and defend your choice like your life depends on it. You are allowed to lie, manipulate and gaslight the room.

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Treasurer Questions:

1. Favourite place to revise or work on campus and why?
2. A good treasurer should at least be okay at maths, choose one of the equations below to solve to show how okay you are.

Level 1: $5x - 8 = 37$ [1 mark]

Level 2: $x^2 - 4x + 1 = 0$ [3 marks]

Level 3: $\frac{dx}{dt} = 4x + y,$ [7 marks]
 $\frac{dy}{dt} = 2x + 3y$
