IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Please confirm student information in **College Board**

- Students can locate their individual testing plan and schedule at <u>myap.collegeboard.org</u>.
- Ensure you're set to receive exam information from College Board (some of which is only sent to students)
- Minimize your risk of potential score delays resulting from incomplete or inaccurate information
- Verify your student ID (your 6-digit lunch code) is in AP Classroom





PAYING FOR/CANCELING EXAMS

- Paying for exams: Exams are \$97 and must be paid for on RevTrak (\$15 for students approved for free or reduced lunch) by November 8th.
- Late order fee: Exams NOT ordered by November 8th will have a \$40 late order fee.
- Unused tests and cancellation fees: There will be a \$40 cancellation fee for unused or canceled exams.

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW BEFORE EXAM DAY!

What should I bring?

- Face coverings are optional
- MUST bring a photo ID (school ID is fine)
- Sharpened #2 pencils with eraser
- Pens with black or dark blue ink
- Up to 2 approved calculators if your exam allows the use of a calculator. Visit this link for the calculator policy
- A ruler or straight edge if you are taking AP Physics (no protractors)
- Optional: a watch that does not have internet access, beep or have an alarm (no smartwatches)





What items are prohibited?

- Electronic equipment including phones, smartwatches, fitness trackers, wearable technology, cameras, recording or listening devices, or any other type of electronic or communication device
- Books, reference guides, notes, compasses, protractors, mechanical pencils, pencils that are not No. 2, correction fluid, dictionaries, highlighters, or colored pencils
- Scratch paper: Students testing in-school are prohibited from bringing scratch paper to the AP Exam, but scratch paper will be provided
- Watches that beep, make a noise, or have an alarm
- Computers or calculators that are not approved
- Reference guides, keyboard maps, or other typing instructions
- Ear plugs
- Clothing or shoes with subject-related information
- Food or drink (water bottles are permitted)
- Clipboards
- Please leave electronics at home or in your vehicle. EHS is not responsible for lost or stolen items. Seat assignments will be given upon arrival.

When/where do I need to show up?

- Most AP exams will be held at EHS, either in the gym, Tiger Den, or library (please double check the schedule above for specific testing locations). Some exams will be held at the Erie Community Center, the Learning Services Center in Longmont, or the United Church in Longmont
- If you are testing at an offsite location, please complete the <u>travel permission form</u> and return to EHS.
- Paper and pencil exams: Morning exams start promptly at 8 AM (arrive BY 7:30 AM) and afternoon exams start promptly at 12:00 PM (arrive BY 11:45 AM). Please make <u>Ms. Russell</u> and <u>Mr. Leopold</u> aware of potential travel concerns.

When will the exam be over?

Timing is different for each test, but morning paper/in school exams should be finished by 12 noon and afternoon paper/in school exams should be completed by 4:30 PM. Students are not dismissed until exams have officially

ended. Do not ask to leave early if you finish before the official end of the test. If you play a sport or have a job, it is <u>your</u> responsibility to make any necessary arrangements. Learn more about exam timing and structure <u>here</u>.

I'm going to be hungry and thirsty. Can I eat during the test?

Following BCPHE guidelines, eating is prohibited during the test session. You can bring a water bottle, but you must keep it under your desk at all times during the test. Please eat a meal prior to the test.

What should I wear?

Dress comfortably, and in layers! It can get chilly in testing rooms, so be prepared with a jacket or sweater.

How does attendance for my EHS classes work on exam day?

Students will be automatically excused from their EHS classes for the entirety of their exam day. Pending on exam timing, students are welcome to attend their classes before or after their exam.

What happens if I get sick or something and have to miss my exam?

Let <u>Ms. Russell</u> know, and you may be registered for an alternate administration. Depending on your reason, you may incur additional fees. <u>Here's the link</u> to testing dates.

I was approved for testing accommodations by the College Board. Where will my test be administered?

Students approved for accommodations will be given their room assignment individually. If you are uncertain on test day, please check in with the front office.

How do I send my scores to colleges?

The deadline for choosing the college, university, or scholarship program that you want to send your 2023 AP scores to for free is **June 20**. Review score send information here.
