

Divergences from the Jahanic timeline at 1444

15th Century

1445: Jaddari is slain by Zokka at Arzaxgorax. The remaining forces of the Desert Legion retreated eastward under the protection of Elaiénna.

1446: Andrellion, being rescued by a Mašnsih man, along with (Insert number here) refugees flee to Davharral, where they later form their own squadrons within the Davharral army.

1447: Jasiene dies fighting Siadan. Jaddaressa and the remaining Elayenna harpies retreat to Ebbusubtu.

144x: Numerous embassies are sent between Keledoras and Re-Uyel, in view of a Re-Uyeli-Birzartanšesi alliance against Baharkand.

1448: Start of the Našra Reclamation War between Birsartanšes and Dartaxagerdim. Re-Uyel is pulled into the conflict as they honor their alliance.

Full Zokka victory in the east.

1450: Tluukt dispatches a messenger to Drolakland, promising the pirate communes of Drolas freedom to raid the Sea of Glass under her protection. Drolakland is driven to rebellion in the Blackflag Coup.

1451: Learning that an Ayarallen army would arrive to relieve Kuzak, Keladora met them on the battlefield. The Harpies were unprepared for the sudden engagement and suffered a crushing defeat. The Siege of Kuzak ended with Keladora's forces breaching the walls and capturing Dartax.

Ambush at Sad Sur. Tluukt's armies annihilate the Elizna force. Irriam intervened in the war against both Tluukt and Elizna, declaring that Elizna had grown astray from fulfilling Jaher's mission and was not capable of protecting the Bulwari. A blockade is imposed over the Drolas peninsula.

1452: Decisive naval victory for Irriam at the battle of Kurmod. Most of the Elizna fleet is sunk. Irriam gains naval supremacy and lays siege to Drolas Tip.

Tluukt occupies the Sad Sur mountains.

1453: Re-Uyel invasion of Crathánor. Birzartanses chartered several fleets, which participated in the blockade of Ovdal Tûngr.

1454: Elizna sues for peace. Drolakand becomes a vassal of Irriam.

Zokka dies after a failed Xhazob ritual. Zokka son-of-Zokka eats his father's heart. The pack nearly falls apart as disloyal Gnolls question the strength of the new ruler.

1455: Tluukt would begin to secretly fund Mašnsih insurgents to lead pockets of resistance within Zokka's territory. However, their funding would be cut short as they

uncover seditious sentiments within Zanbar, forcing them to launch a pre-emptive invasion. However, Sareyand would come to the defense of Zanbar.

Crathánor is reconquered by Re-Uyel.

1458: After conquering Oubbligschild, Landshark would launch several raids into Ourdia with support from Mountainshark. The goblins swarmed the Ourdia army and laid siege to Bal Ouord. In response to the grave setback, the Ourdia appealed to Re-Uyel for aid.

1459: After restoring order in his pack, Zokka would demonstrate his strength by betraying Siadan. After a swift conquest, he casts many harpies into the fellflame.

1461: Zokka invades Azka-Sur. This coincides with the Skewered Drake invasion of Seghidir, leaving the defenders unable to assist each other.

146x: With the support of the Birsartanses, Re-Uyel was able to lead a series of raids against the goblin and put them on the defensive. Eventually leading to Re-Uyel domination in the north.

1463: Tluukt (the groll) is killed by Sareyand. End of Tluukt rule in the Suran plain. The Tluukt pack would become increasingly unstable following her death.

1464: [Death of Taelarios.](#)

1468: Disintegration of the Tluukt pack. Most of it is absorbed by Zokka.

1469: Zokka subdues the Red Stallion tribe and forces them to become a tributary.

1473: Re-Uyel-Birzartanse joint-invasion of Baharkand.

1478: Zokka performs a successful xhazob ritual and becomes the Light Eater Xhaz.

1481: A summit is called due to news of the Xhazob. Tragedy of Samartal. Keladora of the Birzartanses survives the explosion.

1482: Start of the Samartal War between Sareyand and Akalšes against Varamhar

1483: Siege of Traz Buranun.

1485: Zokka invades the Suran plain. Massacre at Harklum. The Sareyand army seizes Traz Buranun but is forced to withdraw from further expansion to deal with the threat.

1487-150x: The Lighteater Xhaz torched through the Suran plain. A mounted army would cross the Sad Sur mountains and march into Elizna where they too would feel the wrath of the Xhaz. For years Bulwar would struggle against the Lighteater. Zokka launched endless raids against nearby untouched population centers. There are rebellions and uprisings. Noble families led coordinated attacks against Zokka while the Gnolls do what they can to retain their acquisitions. But as the years drag on, the occupation of Suran is sapping too much of their strength too quickly for too few rewards. Skewered Drake noticed their weakness, and would begin their own invasion of Azka-Sur. From here, the Drakon riders would descend into Bulwar. It would be all too much for Zokka, who would perish in the Nerament of 150x. The Gnolls are forced to relinquish their conquests as the state violently collapses in on itself. The rest of Bulwar would rejoice as another Xhaz has been defeated.

16th Century

1503: Stand off between the Drakon Riders and the Ash Legion. It threatens to devolve into a new war, but Ghurâd, chieftain of Drakonshan, commands his troops to leave as they consolidate their new empire. Exhausted, the Ash Legion were too battered and could do little but watch them go.

1505: Irrliam had taken control of most of North Salahad by driving out the Gnolls. They had brought with them an army of Šadnatu descent to lead the liberation. A general by the name of Suhlamu would be appointed to govern the territory. On the other hand, Ibtat and the city of Elizna had been taken by peaceful agreement and had to reach an accommodation with existing Elizna forces in the city. After meeting with Thelrion, it was determined that the Elizna royal family would be allowed to continue to govern the cities under Irrliam.

150x: Bulwar established the Naqtazan.

150x: The people of Shasoura grow discontent with Irrliam rule. The differences were exacerbated by Irrliam authorities, in a struggle to enforce ideological uniformity, began enforcing the idea of One Sun over Surakeš.

1510: Restoration of the kingdom of Siadan. The state agrees to become a tributary of Drakonshan for protection.

1516: [The Jaherian Exemplars depart to Aelantir.](#)

1521: The people of Azka-Sur rose in open revolt against Drakonshan. The rebels are brutally subdued, but massacres committed by the Drakonshan army makes them something of a pariah state.

1525: Sareyand takes measures to extend their influence in the area to the north of the Naza Lake. Second invasion of Varamhar commences.

1526: Keladora of Birzartanšes and Thelrion of Irrliam host a grand feast to celebrate their marriage. The moment is used as an occasion to show to all of Bulwar the splendours of the union and to quell memories of hardships brought about by the Xhaz.

1532: Ghurâd, having crushed another rebellion in Bulwar, did not find it difficult to understand why the Bulwari were so resistant to his rule. In a speech to his family and the Drakon riders who accompanied him, he explained that the Bulwari would always see them as harboring the darkness as long as they continued to worship Dookan, who he said in confidence, was likely dead. Yet, bowing to Medurubar and recognizing the Elves as the sole chosen of Surael was out of the question. Instead, he sent envoys to the Sebsadi Orcs who had inhabited Bulwar prior to Drakonshan, whom he requested a religious scholar to teach his people about their ways.

1534: Ghurâd is made aware of the mythical kingdom of Karashar and becomes fascinated by it. He found it to be a convenient message, since the Orcs would better be able to stomach the conversion to the Sun Cult. These ideas would gradually spread across the empire, beginning a top-down conversion of the population in both the Dwarovar and Bulwar.

1538: Sareyand enacts an expulsion edict on the gnolls in the deserts of Bulwar.

1542: Gnoll refugees arrive in Drakonshan. Although welcoming, it is made clear from the onset that Drakonshan will not tolerate any insubordination. And should the Gnolls act up, they will be punished in excruciating detail.

1543: Re-Uyel declares war on Marblehead with Irrliam help.

1547: Marblehead is conquered by Re-Uyel.

155x: Drakonshan begins funding Gnoll resistance against Sareyand and Irrliam in an effort to destabilize the region.

1555: Large but ultimately disorganized anti-Irrliam revolt across Shasoura to reinstate the puppet Elizna king. The Elizna king was hesitant to lead the revolt but ultimately forced into the position.

1557: Nanšalen and Sareyand sign a defensive pact in lieu of a potential Drakonshan invasion from Hul-Jorkad.

1562: Revenge of Medurubar. Revolt crushed. Elizna royal family is massacred. The relationship between Sareyand and Irrliam is severed due to the brutality of the act.

1568: Sareyand-Akalšes war.

1573: Aqatbar Library rebuilt.

1580: Coruvria, claims ancestral ownership over the territory of the Dostanor empire, leading to an invasion of Ourdia. The war with Re-Uyel was initially successful, although Irrliam intervention would stop them from overrunning the area completely.

159x: Arrtukerr naval expansions. Drakonshan encourages the port gnoll naval traditions to compete with the naval powers of Rahen despite the coastal regions being dry and sparsely populated areas separated from the rest of Drakonshan. Construction of a large port in Arrtukerr (the province) would begin.

17th Century

16xx: Beginning in the 17th century, it became increasingly apparent that the Naqtazan was not strong enough to play a decisive role in the war for supremacy in the Suran plain. This was due to the other city states in the alliance feeling increasingly dominated by Bulwar, as well as the relative weakness of the last two successors of the head of the Alukatran family to rule in Bulwar.

16xx: Gnollish guerilla fighters have proven resilient and too costly to continue with occupation, forcing a temporary withdrawal from Sareyand.

16xx: Ghurâd spent many of his later years at Azka-Sur, which had become a sort of second home for him, but despite some extensive palace developments, the city had still struggled to recover from the turmoil in the past centuries. Chieftain Krakhorn's reconstruction was on a different scale. He intended for Azka-Sur to be a second capital of Drakonshan, and so would begin a massive renovation project that would bring Azka-Sur into the limelight.

162x: Drakonshan-Arrtukerr joint expeditions to the Ringlet Isles. Start of the ringlet wars between them, Sardhasi, and the Cannorians. (Ringlet wars are a bunch of small wars over naval supremacy.)

162x: Irrliam and Sareyand compete for influence amongst the remaining Bulwar states, gradual unification as the region consolidates around the two powers.

163x: Light border skirmishes around the Suran plain between Drakonshan and Sareyand. Despite expectation of it escalating into a full conflict, war is avoided in the short term as both deal with pressing issues (Dwarovar shit).

163x: Major reforms to the Ash Legion.

163x: Irrliam-Sareyand war. Irrliam's ambitious plans to unite the Phoenix empire is shattered as Sareyand's valiant defense repulses the invaders.

164x: Council of Birsartansbar. Divorcing the cult of the exemplary, a branch of the NSC formed by the Jaherian Exemplars, from the Taelarian cult.

1656: [Lucian Carter arrives in Drolakand](#). Irrliam takes measures to stamp out the heresy.

169x: Ovdal Tûngr establishes a port in southern Fahvanosy known as the "sweetport".

1700-1821

1702: [Genie relics are found in Rahen's Coast](#).

17xx: Second Drakonshan-Sareyand war. Hostilities in the Upper Suran towards driven by religious and political issues manifest. Although the early years of the war saw few advances on either side, exorbitant growing costs caused a political crisis in Drakonshan forcing them to cede the Suran plain to Sareyand.

17xx: Arrtukerr given nominal independence

173x: Ovdal Tûngr begins colonization of Khugra. Small colonial war with the Cannorians over border dispute.

176x: Ovdal Tûngr colonization of the Baashidi.

1750: Beginning of the Final War of Shadow. Rakkaz pulls Bulwar into the conflict.

1777: End of the Final War of Shadow.

178x: Sareyand and Nanšalen were attacked by Drakonshan. The army stalled at the city of Dahain. Irrliam saw this incursion as a raw act of aggression. Knowing that invading Drakonshan, which would require Sareyand's cooperation, was impossible due to tensions that had arisen following the massacre of Elizna. The Irrliam king instead ordered an invasion of Sareyand to secure the region for themselves as the rightful heir to the phoenix empire. Irrliam would continue to contest with the eastern Bulwari powers for influence in the region from here.

179x-180x: Irrliam had managed to make its way to the outskirts of Bulwar (the city). Drakonshan, being worried about the balance of power shifting in Irrliam's favor and

feeling that they would receive the short end of the stick from the war, would turn on Irriam, calling a truce with Sareyand and Nanšalen to do so. Sareyand used this opportunity to recover their lost territories as the war would progressively revert Irriam gains back to them.

180x: Peace of Traz Suran. Sareyand gains some border territories from Irriam.

Drakonshan seizes parts of the Upper Suran from Sareyand. Neither side is fully happy with the peace.

180x: Eduz-Birnamad is forcibly converted and the Kašra was (allegedly) fed to a Drake for his refusal to convert. This event would cause growing hostilities between the western Elves and Drakonshan.
