



# Christmas Lounge Shorts

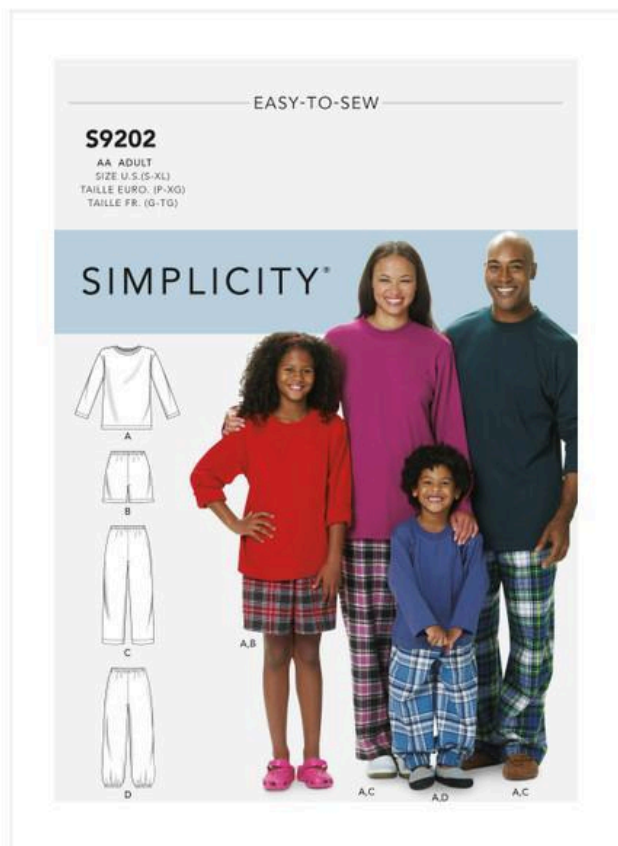

## Description:

This class is part of our Christmas in July series for the shop. These shorts whip up so quickly (especially on a serger) you can make matching pants for the whole family in a weekend! These shorts are loose and comfy making them easy to “fit” with minimal effort. They can be made in cotton woven, knit, flannel, fleece, or whatever fabric you’d like to try! You can sew these pants with a combo serger/cover stitch machine, OR a serger and Sewing machine OR a sewing machine.

We’ll be using this pattern to make the shorts (view B): [Simplicity 9202](#). The shorts can be made of woven fabrics and stable knits.

**CHILD'S AND ADULTS' LOUNGEWEAR, TOP, SHORTS AND PANTS**

**Fabrics:** **A Top:** Moderate Stretch Knits only such as Waffle Knits, Sweatshirting, Cotton Knit and Stretch Velour. **Contrast Neckband:** Rib Knit. **B Shorts or C,D Pants:** Lightweight Flannel, Lightweight Broadcloth, Cotton Blends and Stable Knits. See Pick-A-Rain® Rule. Suitable for Overlock/Serger. Extra fabric needed to match plaids, stripes or one-way design fabrics.

**Notions:** Thread. **B, C:** 1" (2.50cm) wide elastic; ¼ yd. (0.80m) for child, 1½ yds. (1.40m) for adult. **D:** 1" (2.50cm) elastic; 1¼ yds. (1.60m) for child, 2½ yds. (2.30m) for adult.

Skills you will learn:  
 Measuring yourself to determine pattern size  
 Side seam pockets

Hemming

Elastic waistband construction

Make sure your machines are in good working order and remember to bring your manual!

**Supplies you will need for class:**

- o Machine in good working order
- o Bring:
  - o foot pedal,
  - o power cord,
  - o any feet and accessories that came with your machine
  - o your user manual
- o Needles appropriate for your machine and fabric
- o Simplicity pattern 9202
- o Fabric and elastic amounts indicated on pattern based on your size
- o Thread to coordinate with fabric
- o Scissors, snips, rotary cutter
- o Clips or pins
- o Measuring tape
- o Blunt needle for weaving in thread tails
- o Any other items you like to have while serging and sewing, i.e. a slipper for your "driving foot"
