 - \$175.00 per gymnast for USA Developmental Program Junior Elite Level 8JE, 9JE, 10JE
 - Clubs will *pay with one business check* for all qualified athletes who will be attending at the conclusion of their state championship to their state chairman
 - No personal checks will be accepted

Entry Fee Information:

- If a gymnast qualifies, they **must register** at the conclusion of their session at the State Championship.
- The entry fee is **non-refundable**.
 - o There is no refund for athletes once the entry fee has been paid to the State Chairman
 - o The only exception to this rule is for a Petition Athlete. (As per Region VIII Board Meeting October 16, 2009).

AWARDS - For all awards at Region 8 Championship, all levels and divisions will be divided into equal age groups based upon the total number of athletes in that session.



2023 State Allotment Numbers

For Levels 3 - 5, Gymnasts qualify in rank order by <u>combining all age groups</u> in the All – Around at their respective State Championship. Otherwise, the Coach must submit a petition to the State Chairman.

Regional Registration Procedure and Checklist

Coaches and Gym Owners, please read this information carefully.

- **Registration of athletes to the Regional Championships will be handled by the coach only.** Placing coaches in charge of this procedure simplifies the Registration process considerably.
- **Prior to the state championship**, coaches should verify which of their athletes will attend the Regional Championships, if qualified.
 - o Print a copy of your clubs state championship USAG Meet Reservation and mark off the athletes and coaches who WILL NOT be attending the regional championship
- Bring with you petitions with all supporting documentation
- Coaches must bring a Club Business Check to pay for all Regional entry fees at State Championship
- The State Chairman will provide coaches the location and times for registering their athletes.
 - Coaches must register all qualifying athletes **prior** to leaving state championship
 - All entry fees must be paid to your State Chairman, by check by the end of State Championships.
 - Fees include all qualifying athletes and petition athletes
 - Fees are non-refundable once an athlete has been registered, with the exception of petition athletes

Coaches, bring the following items to State Championships:

____ A Business Check from your gym to pay the entry fees.

- \$160.00 per gymnast for USAG Development Program Levels 3 7, 8JN, 9JN, 10JN
- \$175.00 per gymnast for USAG Development Program Junior Elite Level 8JE, 9JE, and 10JE
- Make Checks payable to your State Chairman
- _____ A list of all the athletes and coaches from your gym that will attend Region 8 Championship, if they qualify.
- _____ Injury Petitions with all supporting documents

<u>Petition Information</u> ALL PETITIONS TO THE 2023 REGIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS MUST BE SUBMITTED TO YOUR STATE CHAIRMAN AT STATE CHAMPIONSHIP. No petitions will be accepted if sent directly to the Regional Chairman.

If an athlete is injured, a Petition to the Region VIII Championships *must be submitted to the State Chairman at the State Championships*. The State Chairman will then send all petitions to the Regional Chairman for evaluation and approval. Petitions will be very strictly evaluated. *Petitions without the required supporting documentations will not be considered*.

- Petitions must be turned in at the State Championship and petition athletes must pay for Regional Championship at the State Championship.
- Petitions that are not approved will receive a refund.
- A completed petition must include the following information:
- Injury Petition Form available at: (www.usagym.org/PDFs/Men/Rules/Rules%20and%20Policies/injury-petition.pdf)
 - Scores from two (2) USAG Sanctioned Meets during the 2022-2023 season -
 - If Petitioning for JE, Technical Sequence scores must also be included along with Optional Routine scores.
 - A Physician's note specifying the injury and the date the athlete is cleared **completely** for participation.
