Election Iss<mark>ues Project</mark>



In this project you will choose an <u>election issue</u> to research and learn about. You will present your learning using still images (short video clips optional) and voice narration in the <u>iMovie app</u>.

The point of the project is to present both sides of the issue and not so much about picking a side nor convincing people of what you think is right. You are to be as objective as possible and present the facts.

You should include the following information in your iMovie video:

- an explanation of what the issue is
- historical background that may aid in people's understanding on the issue; what has happened in the past that resulted in this becoming an issue in the first place?
- arguments on both sides of the issue; pros and cons to proposed solutions on both sides (if any)

Keep track of where you are getting all of your information and images in a Google Doc. Use an url shortener (<u>TinyURL</u>, <u>Bitly</u>, <u>Google</u>) to create an easy way of getting to your "Works Cited" page. This shortened url should appear on the last slide of your iMovie video.

Halfway through the project, you will give a synopsis of what you have learned through your research via this <u>Google Form</u>.

When your iMovie video is done, upload the video to Google Drive and process a link set to "anyone with the link can view," then submit to Google Classroom to turn in your project.
