Distinguished Alumni will be selected by the MCHS Distinguished Alumni Recognition Committee based upon the following guiding statement and criteria:

Mira Costa High School Distinguished Alumni will be honored by staff, students and fellow alumni for notable contributions to the arts, sciences, education, athletics, entertainment, social, environmental, and business management; and/or exemplary service to their communities and country. The Mira Costa family and community acknowledge, with gratitude and appreciation, each of the alumni for his/her exceptional contributions and achievements. Their honorable distinctions serve as reminders of the potential in all of us to transform knowledge, skill, and challenge into action for the benefit of others. Current and future generations at Mira Costa High School will find inspiration and determination from the memorable successes of these past distinguished graduates who attribute their personal and professional achievements to their MCHS education and experience.

PROCESS AND SELECTION CRITERIA

Process:

- Nominees MUST have graduated from Mira Costa High School, Manhattan Beach, California. Attendance not culminating in graduation disqualifies someone from consideration.
- Only activities in which the nominee participated *after* graduation will be considered by the selection committee. No accomplishments or honors earned in high school are relevant. Nominees have served, inspired, or achieved at local, regional, national or international levels in the arts, science, academia, athletics, entertainment, business, civics, the humanities, human services, literature, medicine, the military, philanthropy, public service, etc.
- Anyone may nominate an MCHS alum for the MCHS Distinguished Alumni Award and Hall of Fame, except the nominee; NO self-nominations. It is not necessary to have attended MCHS to nominate a candidate.
- Alumni may be nominated posthumously.
- Nominations are due March 10, 2024. Selections will be made in April and recipients will be notified no later than the end of May.
- Incomplete nominations will not be considered.
- Nominations expire when the selection committee completes its work each year. Candidates not selected as a Distinguished Alumni must be renominated the following year to be considered again.

Selection Criteria:

- To qualify for selection,
 - Nominees have excelled in their chosen field(s) *and*
 - Their achievement(s) must now have or have had a positive impact on the advancement of that field *and*
 - Their achievement(s) must now have or have had a positive impact on the human community locally, statewide, nationally and/or globally.
