Halloween Safety

Today, SRO Steve Doughty visited Nassau Elementary classrooms to review safety rules for Halloween. The students watched a short video about Halloween safety that emphasized basic ground rules: walking, not running; standing out in the dark using a flashlight, glow sticks, or reflectors; traveling in groups in well-lit areas with an adult; checking candy for choking hazards or tampering; and making sure drivers see you. Officer Doughty reviewed these points in detail, asking many questions. The students were very excited about the upcoming holiday.
