Every attempt will be made to place you in the courses you select, however requests will not be accommodated if courses are unavailable, conflicts arise, or the appropriate prerequisites have not been met.

Students who sign up for an AP course may be required to complete a summer assignment to secure enrollment in the class. It is the students' responsibility to obtain this summer assignment from the AP teacher prior to the end of the school year.

Classes with an asterisk (*) have a grade or course prerequisite or require a teacher recommendation, or audition. Classes with a double asterisk (**) require an application. Refer to the [Course Description Book](#) for more information.
