Terms of Service

A. General

- By commissioning a NSFW piece, the client agrees that they are over 18 years old and that all characters portrayed in the artwork are adults.
- The artist reserves the right to choose which clients to work with and the right to cancel and issue a refund anytime.
- Civil communication from both ends is required. Please respect each other's boundaries, privacy, off-hours, etc. All information shared between the artist and the client is confidential. Expect/allow for response times of up to 1 day.
- o Commissions will be prioritized and completed in order of gueue.
- The artist will provide updates periodically. The client may request status updates if 2 weeks have passed without any update.
- The client may request revisions (see E. General Work Timeline for details)
- Once work on a piece has started, expect ~1-2 months max completion time.
- Upon completion, the client will receive a link to a Google Drive folder containing the final commissioned artwork, or receive the files directly through Telegram.

B. Payment Policy

- All prices are in USD (\$)
- After the artist and client have discussed and agreed on the final price, an invoice will be sent to the client's email that must be paid in full through PayPal. This invoice should be paid within a reasonable amount of time.
- WIPs will not be shared until a payment is made.

C. Cancellation and Refund Policy

- Before the payment is made, the client may cancel anytime, no questions asked.
- After the payment is made and progress on the commission has started, the client may cancel in all cases except:
 - Commissions that are already over ~90% finished
 - Upon completion of the commission, no refunds of any kind will be considered.
- The artist reserves the right to cancel anytime.
- If a cancellation is made, the client will receive a partial refund based on how much progress was made. The artist reserves the right to propose a refund percentage to discuss with the client.

D. Usage Policy

- The client may use the finished commissioned piece for any personal use, such as printing or posting the piece online, as long as the artist is credited somewhere.
- The client may not use the commissioned piece for any commercial use, such as the sale of files or rights to the image, unless discussed and given permission beforehand. I will not give permission for usage in generative AI or NFTs.

• The artist may post the commissioned piece online unless an agreement is made to keep the piece private, prior to payment.

E. General Work Timeline

- The client fills out a commission request form. You may DM me for any questions on what I'm willing or unwilling to draw if you're unsure. I may also contact you through your preferred contact method for further details and questions about the request. If I accept the commission, I will notify you through your preferred contact method.
- 2. Upon accepting the commission, we will discuss in further detail. Once the basic idea and final price is settled, the client will receive an invoice that must be paid in full and in a timely manner.
- 3. **Tiers 1, 2, 3**: After the payment is completed, sketching will start. Rough sketches will be sent to the client periodically for approval. During this period, the client can request changes or alternate takes (within reason) until they are satisfied with the sketch.
- 4. **Tier 2, 3**: Once a final sketch is approved, work will begin on the final line art + flat base colors. This is largely an independent process so WIPs will generally not be shared regularly unless requested. Once this is finished, it will be sent to the client for approval.
 - At this point, requests for changes to the underlying sketch may require additional fees depending on complexity, as the client had the opportunity to request them earlier.
- 5. Tier 3: Once the final lines and base colors are approved, work will begin on the final render. This is largely an independent process so WIPs will generally not be shared regularly unless requested. Once this is finished, it will be sent to the client for approval.
 - Please note that the final lines and colors will likely not match the base exactly after accounting for shading, lighting, and color balancing. At this point, requests for changes to the underlying sketch/lines may require additional fees depending on complexity, as the client had the opportunity to request them earlier.
- 6. The final piece will be sent through a link to a Google Drive folder or directly through Telegram and the commission will be considered finished. Upon completion, tweaks to small details can be made for free, but larger alterations may require an additional fee.
