- Groups are not permitted to use amplified sound of any type. Set-up and check-in begins at 2pm and all activities must cease at 5pm.
- All groups must clean up their table at the conclusion of the event.
- In the case of rain, you may have to share a table with another group. We will make the rain call early in the morning on the day of the event and you will be notified via email.
