Pandit Raghunath Murmu Medical College is a public college established in 2017. It is affiliated with North Orissa University and located in Odisha. The college received recognitions from National Medical Commission, Medical Commission of India, Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, and Directorate of Medical Education and Training, Odisha.

The college offers undergraduate medical education, with MBBS as the primary course. The MBBS duration is 5.5 years, which includes a one-year internship. The annual tuition fee for the MBBS course is approximately ₹26,350. The college also offers diploma-level programs in specific specializations, including anatomy, microbiology, pediatrics, general medicine, forensic medicine, and more.

Admissions to the MBBS course at Pandit Raghunath Murmu Medical College are based on the NEET-UG entrance exam. Candidates must have completed 10+2 with at least 50% marks in physics, chemistry, and biology to be eligible. Applications are accepted through the online admission portal of the college.

Ranking

Courses and fees

Placements

Unlike private colleges, Pandit Raghunath Murmu Medical College (PRMMCH) in Baripada, Odisha, does not provide conventional campus placements. Nonetheless, the majority of graduates either pursue postgraduate study or land jobs in public health services or government hospitals. A mandatory one-year internship with a salary is a component of the MBBS curriculum.

Government Employment Opportunities: The Odisha Public Service Commission (OPSC) and other pertinent organizations frequently hold recruiting campaigns that place graduates in government hospitals.

Internship: Following completion of the MBBS program, a one-year internship is required.

Stipend for Internship: Students normally earn a monthly stipend during their internship, which can range from ₹20,000 to ₹30,000.

Scholarship

Students at Mayurbhanj, Odisha's Pandit Raghunath Murmu Medical College & Hospital are eligible for a number of scholarships. These include scholarships for students from economically disadvantaged groups and merit-based scholarships for exceptional achievers. In order to assist students in obtaining school loans, the college also collaborates with financial institutions.

Admission process

Admission process

1.NEET-UG Exam:

- The National Testing Agency (NTA) administers the NEET-UG exam, which candidates must register for and take.
- In June or July, the NEET-UG results are often released.
- In order to proceed, candidates must achieve the NEET-UG minimum qualifying percentage.

2. State Counseling Registration:

- The Directorate of Medical Education & Training (DMET), Odisha, requires candidates who qualified for NEET-UG to register for the state counseling process. The state counseling authority often announces the registration dates.
- In accordance with the counseling standards, candidates must upload the required documents during registration.

3. Document Verification:

- In accordance with the timetable and protocol established by the counseling authority, candidates must take part in the document verification process.
- Original records such as NEET-UG.

Eligibility criteria

Pandit Raghunath Murmu Medical College admissions are based on entrance exams and academic eligibility. For admission to the MBBS program, candidates must have passed 10+2 with at least 50% marks in physics, chemistry, and biology, and must qualify in the NEET-UG exam. The college accepts all the applications through its official admission portal.

Cutoff

The NEET cutoff for MBBS at Pandit Raghunath Murmu Medical College and Hospital, Baripada, differed by category. The closing rank for the General AI quota varied from 14162 to 20352. The range for OBC was 16250–20635. The cutoff for the SC and ST categories was between 65632 and 93316 and 132005 and 135328, respectively.
