Justification

Methodological update is essential for the achievement of educational objectives within a framework of plurilingual training. The Education Department of the Regional Government of Castilla y León considers essential to offer permanent quality training for teachers to develop their teaching skills in schools with bilingual section in Castilla y León.

Bilingual teachers are demanding specific CLIL training applied to each subject taught in this program. Also, the knowledge of innovative techniques and the use of authentic materials in non-linguistic subjects are required in our classes.

Objectives

1. To deepen understanding and skills on CLIL methodology.
2. To apply main CLIL principles to the design of didactic units in different subjects for the bilingual classroom.
3. To raise awareness on the importance of designing and developing cross curricular activities in CLIL contexts.
4. To know specific techniques for the assessment and evaluation process in the bilingual classroom.

2. Basic principles in CLIL didactic units design applied to different subjects.
3. Designing and developing cross curricular activities in CLIL contexts.
4. Assessment and evaluation techniques in the bilingual classroom. Formative and summative evaluation.
