

## Youth Career Advisors

Rural Minnesota Concentrated Employment Program (RMCEP) career advising program works in partnership with schools to offer students the information and resources they need to make the best decisions about a path to employment post-graduation.

Advisors share information about specific career pathways, especially for sectors where employees are in demand. Students learn the value of continuing education, not just a traditional 4-year degree, but also postsecondary training programs and alternative options.

The Student Success Center offers two Youth Career Advisors who can assist in the following areas:

**Career Planning:** career exploration, developing a career plan, completing a personal learning plan, navigating MCIS

**College Planning:** selecting a college, completing college applications, financial aid, completing scholarship applications

**Employment Planning:** researching employment opportunities, job search strategies, completing job applications, interviewing techniques & mock interviews
