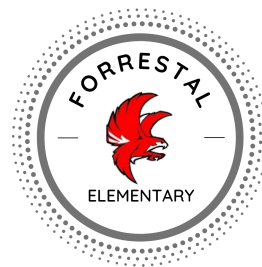

Testing begins on Tuesday, May 10th

What is MAP?

It's a computer adaptive test created by NWEA that students take three times per school year. The results provide teachers with information to help them deliver appropriate content for each student and determine each student's academic growth over time.



How can you support at home?

- make sure your student is at school & on time
- get plenty of rest
- eat a healthy breakfast
- Advise your child not to worry about the test—just to do the best they can

Why is this important?

- It helps show teachers what students know
- It drives small group instruction
- It measures what students know
- It's a benchmark assessment
