The Laichankee Studio Mentorship programme is designed for recent art degree programme graduates, specifically those who have graduated within the past 1-3 years. This six-month programme offers a comprehensive learning experience.

Target : Fresh university graduate (1-3 years) / Interested long-term Laichankee students

Fee: \$4500 per month

Participating Mentees: 2 at the same period

Materials/ Purchasing materials support:

- Wood-board 30 x 40 cm (10 pieces)
- Shelf for storage area: 60(D) x 70(W) x 190(H) cm

Recycling clay for testing: Defaulted Clay - Danish White; Lava
Purchasing materials (Paid by mentee)

Firing schedule: 4 - 6 times in a month (3 bisque and 3 high-firing)

Specific Individual firing cost: Extra add-on fee

- Recycling box for special clay

Mentees will have full access to all Laichankee facilities across three studios, including kilns, wheels, slab-rollers, moulding areas, and glazing tables. Studio assistants and systematic arrangements support these facilities to ensure a productive working environment. Mentees are also welcome to store their tools and materials in a designated storage area within the studio.
