FY26 budget surplus

- Lively discussion in Connect- still need to nail down consensus
 - Of most interest:
 - Covering AV & food at ALA Play
 - T-shirts / special swag for members staffing GameRT booth at Annual (\$1500)
 - Tote bags (so we don't have to collect sizes)
 - Custom dice
 - Enamel pin for volunteers on ALL committees, regardless of Annual attendance
 - o Of interest but need more clarity to pursue:
 - Paying keynote speakers
 - Travel grant to attend Annual
 - Covering the cost of Annual for smaller publishers
 - How guaranteed is this surplus? Need to answer this before planning on more long-term / continual plans
- Definitely buying games for Grove, including Award winners
- Action item: Gather quotes for custom dice, lanyards, enamel pins & post to Connect thread in order to continue the discussion Molly
