## PRIMARY FUNCTION:

As the *OST Program Coordinator*, you will work closely with the *Youth & Families Coordinator* to support the planning, organization, and implementation of youth programs and activities. From assisting with program development to providing guidance and support to participants, you'll be instrumental in creating a safe, inclusive, and engaging environment for all youth involved.

## **KEY JOB RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- 1. Managing all aspects of OST programming, including direct care with youth participants as needed.
- 2. Foster a positive and inclusive atmosphere that promotes the physical, mental, and social well-being of youth participants.
- 3. Provide guidance and support to youth participants, promoting positive behavior and conflict resolution skills.
- 4. Maintain accurate program records.
- 5. Assist in recruiting, hiring, training, and supervising of program staff and volunteers.
- 6. Maintain partnerships with school districts and other community groups.

- Bachelor's degree in education, social work, or related field preferred.
- Experience working with youth in an educational, community-based, or recreational setting.
- Strong interpersonal and communication skills.
- Strong leadership abilities and the ability to work as part of a team.
- Organizational skills to be able to multitask several duties at the same time.
