

Job Descriptions/Qualifications/Experience

Welding 1: Instructor shall teach beginning students- mostly high school age- the fundamentals of SMAW welding, oxyfuel cutting, and base metal prep. In addition to the lab (practical) aspect of the class, students shall also be taught welding safety, the essential SMAW equipment, and how to set- up and care for equipment. Instructor shall be diligent in his or her efforts to make sure all students are working safely and wearing proper ppe. At the conclusion of the course students shall test for D1.1 1G and 2G, and the expectation is that the instructor is teaching with this test in mind.

Day and Time: Class meets on Saturdays for 4 hours from 8am to 12noon. Duration approximately-January- June.

Qualifications/Experience

- AWS, LA City D1.1 or equivalent certification (applicant will be required to test to verify)
- Pass a Lifescan

Compensation: Depends on experience and skill level

Construction 1: Instructor shall teach beginning students- mostly high school age- the fundamentals of rough framing carpentry. Essential skills students shall learn include the ability to: level, square, measure and cut accurately, properly use a speed square to cut roof rafters, and build floor, wall and roof systems.. Instructor is expected to teach students construction safety including the proper use of all hand and power tools. Instructor shall be diligent in his or her efforts to make sure all students are working safely and wearing proper ppe. At the conclusion of the course students shall test for NCCER CORE certification, and the expectation is that the instructor is teaching with this test in mind.

Dates and times: Class runs from January through the beginning/middle of June. Class meets Saturdays from 8am -12noon.

Qualifications/Experience:

- Minimum five years experience in rough framing construction(residential and/or commercial). Applicant will be required to test to verify)
