KEY DATES & EVENTS

- **Wednesday, October 14, 2026** — SAT School Day for seniors only. We will be offering the SAT on campus this year!
- **Senior Serve Day at Waterman Cove Assisted Living in Tavares — Tuesday, November 17, 2026.** We will leave the school at 8:00 am, arrive at the facility at 8:30, and work till 11. We will be decorating doors and singing Christmas carols in the recreational room if time allows. You will need to bring money to cover your lunch — we usually go to the Target parking lot in Mt. Dora and students group together to eat lunch and, if time allows, do a little shopping or

grab coffee. We will be back to school by 2:00 pm. We will be taking the school vans for transportation — students are not allowed to drive themselves there.

- **Fall Festival Fundraiser — Friday, November 20, 2026.** We usually rent a dunk tank to use as a fundraiser toward your senior trip. Who wants to help organize this? Parents, I will also need a parent to volunteer to be at the tank with the students — if you can and are willing to help, please let me know. We will also be running a bake sale table ... more info on this later.
- **Mt. Dora Christmas Parade — Saturday, December 5, 2026, time 10:00 am.** We line up at 9:00; more information on our float location will be sent out later. I would love for y'all to come out and help with this!
- **Senior Hoodies/T-Shirts** — as always, we're happy to be working on these. We'll plan a lunch meeting to get your ideas and suggestions very soon (Sep/Oct), which will also feature the senior verse.
- **Caps & Gowns** will be ordered the first week we return from Christmas break. The graduation fee is \$200.00, which will be charged to your FACTS account on **January 8, 2027**. This covers the cost of graduation and your cap and gown (yours to keep). There is no admission charge for this event.

SENIOR TRIP & FUNDRAISING

Casual Day sales help offset the cost of the senior trip. We'll need 6 workers each morning:

- Wednesday, October 7, 2026
- Wednesday, November 11, 2026
- Wednesday, January 13, 2027
- Wednesday, February 3, 2027

The senior trip is booked for [Lake Swan Camp](#) in Melrose, FL, for **February 10–12, 2027**. The cost will be a maximum of \$225, depending on how much is raised through Fall Festival and Casual Day sales — last year's fundraising brought it down to \$135 per student. You must help with fundraisers to receive a discount on the price. We will leave Wednesday morning at 8:15 and return to school Friday around noon. Payment for the senior trip will be due end of January – first of February.
